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**SLS 161ES** 

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Limits the period for carryforward of net operating losses. (gov sig)

<u>Current law</u> allows corporations to deduct from their Louisiana net income in a particular year operating losses they incurred in other years. Losses incurred in a year can be carried forward for twenty years and deducted from positive net income in any of those years, reducing tax liabilities in those years. Act 103 of the 2015 session added five years to the previously allowed fifteen years.

Proposed law returns the carry-forward period to fifteen years.

Applicable to all claims for this deduction on any return filed on or after April 1, 2016, regardless of the taxable year to which the return relates.

When five-years was added to the then fifteen year carry-foward period by Act 103 of 2015, no material change to the state's exposure to NOL deductions was anticipated. Likewise, the return to a fifteen period after less than one year of the longer allowance is also not expected to materially affect the state's existing exposure to NOL deductions.
