PROCUREMENT CODE. Require all flags purchased by the state of Louisiana to be made in the United States. (8/1/16)

1 AN ACT

2 To enact R.S. 49:153.4, relative to the purchase of flags, to provide for specific

3 manufacturing; and to provide for related matters.

4 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

5 Section 1. R.S. 49:153.4 is hereby enacted to read as follows:

6 **§153.4. Purchase of United States flag or state flag for public use**

7 **When the state purchases a United States flag or a state flag for public**

8 **use, the flag shall be made in the United States from articles, materials, or**

9 **supplies, all of which are grown, produced, and manufactured in the United**

10 **States.**
