AN ACT 1 2 To enact R.S. 17:3995(A)(7), relative to funding for charter schools; to provide relative to 3 the allocation of minimum foundation program funding to virtual charter schools; and to provide for related matters. 4 5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana: 6 Section 1. R.S. 17:3995(A)(7) is hereby enacted to read as follows: §3995. Charter school funding 8 A.(1)9 (7) Notwithstanding any other provision of this Section, the per pupil 10 amount provided to a virtual charter school shall be computed annually and 11 shall be equal to fifty percent of the state portion and fifty percent of the local portion of the per pupil amount provided through the minimum foundation 12 13 program formula for the school district in which the student resides, or the virtual charter school is located, whichever is the lesser total amount. The 14 15 remaining fifty percent of both the state and local portion of the per pupil 16 amount shall be provided to the school district in which the student resides.

<u>Present law</u> provides for the allocation of minimum foundation program funds to charter schools as provided in the approved minimum foundation program formula.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that, notwithstanding any provision of <u>present law</u>, the per pupil amount provided to a charter school shall be computed annually and shall be equal to fifty percent of the state portion and fifty percent of the local portion of the per pupil amount provided through the minimum foundation program formula for the school district in which the student resides or the virtual charter school is located, whichever is the lesser total amount.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that the remaining fifty percent of both the state and local portion of the per pupil amount shall be provided to the local school district in which the student resides.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
