Colomb

<u>Present law</u> provides a definition of practice of chiropractic as diagnosing conditions of the spine. <u>Proposed law</u> changes the definition to include examining, evaluating, and diagnosing patients for the purpose of determining neuromusculoskeletal conditions associated with the functional integrity of the spine or its extremities or both.

<u>Present law</u> provides that the practice of chiropractic is to correct interference with normal nerve transmission and expression. <u>Proposed law</u> adds to restore normal function on the neuromuscular and skeletal system, to relieve pain, or to prevent disability.

<u>Present law provides that a chiropractor can make recommendations on personal hygiene.</u> <u>Proposed law provides for recommendations on health and wellness.</u>

Effective upon signature of the governor or upon lapse of gubernatorial action.
