Donahue

<u>Present law</u> provides for various limitations on appropriations relative to state general funds and dedicated funds.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and add provision that appropriations by the legislature from mineral revenues generated from the price of oil received by the state in excess of forty dollars per barrel shall be limited to the purposes set forth in the constitution relative to money in the forecast designated as nonrecurring.

Effective July 1, 2016.
