Subject: Scholarships for Children of Wildlife and Fisheries Agents	

STUDENT/LOANS-SCHOLARSHIP OR NO IMPACT See Note Page 1 of 1
Provides relative to tuition and fee exemptions for children of Dept. of Wildlife and Fisheries enforcement agents killed or permanently disabled in the performance of duty

Present law provides scholarships with certain limitations for children of a police officer, deputy sheriff, or adult probation and parole officer within the division of probation and parole of the Department of Public Safety and Corrections who are killed or permanently disabled in the performance of their duties after January 1, 1973. Proposed law extends these scholarship to children of Department of Wildlife and Fisheries enforcement agents who are killed or permanently disabled in the performance of his duties.

EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental expenditures as a result of this measure as these children are already eligible for scholarships.

Children of enforcement agents who are killed or permanently disabled in the performance of his duties are currently eligible for scholarships. For purposes related to special scholarships children of police officers, deputy sheriffs, or certain probation and parole officers killed or permanently disabled in performance of duty, R.S. 17:1681(A) defines a police officer as a person employed or engaged as commissioned police officers on a full-time basis by the State of Louisiana or any of its political subdivisions. Wildlife and Fisheries enforcement agents are commissioned police officers.
