





Proposed law removes any reference to Orleans in present law as per *State v. Dilosa*, 848 So. 2d 546, 551 (La.2003).

Present law provided that in Orleans Parish, a grand jury venire shall be drawn by the jury commission on the date set by the presiding judge. Present law provides on the next legal day following the drawing, the jury commission shall submit the grand jury venire to the presiding judge, who shall impanel the grand jury. Present law provides that a grand jury in Orleans Parish shall be impaneled on the first Wednesday of March and September of each year.

Proposed law removes present law held unconstitutional by *State v. Dilosa*, 848 So. 2d 546, 551 (La.2003).
