ATHLETICS/TRAINERS: Authorizes public school governing authorities to require at least one coach for each sport offered by a public school to be certified in cardiopulmonary resuscitation

1 AN ACT

2 To enact R.S. 17:81(AA), relative to extracurricular sports offered by public schools; to  
3 authorize public school governing authorities to require a minimum number of  
4 coaching staff for each sport to have certain health training certifications; and to  
5 provide for related matters.

6 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

7 Section 1. This Act shall be known as the "Cole Tracey Act".

8 Section 2. R.S. 17:81(AA) is hereby enacted to read as follows:

9 §81. General powers of local public school boards

10 \* \* \*

11 (AA) The governing authority of each public school may require that at least  
12 one member of the coaching staff for each extracurricular sport offered by the school  
13 is certified in cardiopulmonary resuscitation.

Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

The Committee Amendments Proposed by House Committee on Education to the original bill:

1. Instead of requiring public school governing authorities to ensure that at least two members of the coaching staff for each sport are CPR-certified, authorize them to require that at least one member of such staff have such certification.
