Present law requires for an elected chief of police of a municipality to be an elector of the municipality.

Present law provides that at the time of qualification as a candidate for the office of chief of police, the candidate must have been domiciled for at least the immediately preceding year in the municipality. Provides as an exception that a person who resides outside of the corporate limits of the village of Maurice may be elected chief of police of Maurice.

Proposed law retains present law and adds to the exception that a person who resides outside of the corporate limits of the town of Gueydan may be elected chief of police of the town of Gueydan.

Effective August 1, 2016.
