**FEES/LICENSES/PERMITS: Establishes an application fee for a new marijuana pharmacy permit and limits eligibility for the permit**

**DIGEST**

Present law establishes the schedule of minimum amounts for fees to be collected by the La. Board of Pharmacy.

Proposed law retains present law and adds a new medical marijuana pharmacy permit application fee with a minimum amount of \$5000.

Proposed law prohibits a current member of the La. Board of Pharmacy or his immediate family from applying for a new medical marijuana permit. Further prohibits a person who was a member of the La. Board of Pharmacy or his immediate family from applying for a new medical marijuana permit within two years of the last day of his term on the board.

(Adds R.S. 37:1184(3)(k))

Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

The House Floor Amendments to the engrossed bill:

1. Prohibit a current member of the La. Board of Pharmacy or his immediate family from applying for a new marijuana permit.
2. Prohibit a person who was a member of the La. Board of Pharmacy or his immediate family from applying for a new marijuana permit within two years of the last day of his term on the board.

Summary of Amendments Adopted by Senate

Committee Amendments Proposed by Senate Committee on Health and Welfare to the reengrossed bill

1. Clarifies that the new pharmacy permit applies only to medical marijuana.
