1 A RESOLUTION

2 To commend the Kentwood High School football team upon winning the 2015 Louisiana
3 High School Athletic Association Class 1A state championship.

4 WHEREAS, it is appropriate to commend the Kentwood High School football team
5 upon winning the 2015 Louisiana High School Athletic Association (LHSAA) Class 1A
6 state championship; and

7 WHEREAS, the Kangaroos of the Kentwood High School football team have
8 completed a sensational season, earning the title of 2015 LHSAA Class 1A state champions
9 after blowing away the two-time defending state champion, the Haynesville Golden
10 Tornados, by a score of 40-7 in a fast-paced, exciting championship game Friday, December
11 11, 2015, at the Mercedes-Benz Superdome in New Orleans; and
