- HCR4 Bourriaque FEDERAL PROGRAMS
Requests the division of administration, office of community development, to include certain activities as eligible expenses in the development of its Community Development Block Grant - Disaster Recovery Program Action Plans
- Read by title, ordered engrossed, passed to 3rd reading.
 - Scheduled for floor debate on 10/02/20.
- HCR5 Schexnayder TAX/TAX REBATES
Suspends the authority of the secretary of the Department of Revenue to enter into new contracts or renewals of existing contracts pursuant to the Procurement Processing Company Rebate Program (Item #65)
- Discharged from the Committee on Ways and Means.
 - Withdrawn from the files of the House.
- HCR6 Landry LEGISLATIVE BUDG CONTROL
Directs the Legislative Budgetary Control Council to review the compensation of legislative assistants and to establish a salary schedule for legislative assistants that is competitive with the marketplace
- Read by title, ordered engrossed, passed to 3rd reading.
 - Scheduled for floor debate on 10/02/20.
- HCR14 Duplessis VOTING/REGISTRATION
Requests the secretary of state to adopt a policy to ensure that routine maintenance of the Department of State's online voter registration system does not occur during certain time periods

- HCR15 Ivey EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS
Suspends certain provisions of the Louisiana Health Emergency Powers Act (Items #2, 28, and 41)
