HB14	Stefanski	GAMBLING/VIDEO POKER	Provides relative to the criteria and amenity requirements for qualified truck stops during a declared emergency (Item #32) - Received from the Senate without amendments.
HB24	Zeringue	CAPITAL OUTLAY	Provides relative to the capital outlay budget (Item #15) - Notice of Senate conferees appointed.

Finally passed, title adopted, ordered to the Senate.
HB43	Bacala	NURSING HOMES	Provides for rights of nursing home residents relative to visitation (Item #59) - Reported with amendments (15-0). - Rules suspended. - Read by title, amended, ordered engrossed, passed to 3rd reading. - Scheduled for floor debate on 10/15/20.
HB66	Beaullieu	UNEMPLOYMENT COMP	Provides relative to the state's unemployment insurance program and data sharing (Item #64) - Read third time by title, amended, roll called on final passage, yeas 101, nays 0. Finally passed, title adopted, ordered to the Senate.
HB69	McFarland	WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT	Creates the "Louisiana Agricultural Workforce Development Program" (Item #67)

Provides relative to the use of tax increment financing by the Downtown Economic Development District for the City of Monroe (Item #66)
- Read third time by title, roll called on final passage, yeas 100, nays 0. Finally passed, title adopted, ordered to the Senate.
- HB81 Garofalo STUDENTS
Prohibits a school from sharing a student's personally identifiable information relative to illness or disease with the Dept. of Health for purposes of the Sanitary Code or any other purpose without parental consent (Item #42)
- Reported favorably (11-0).
- Rules suspended.
- Read by title, ordered engrossed, passed to 3rd reading.
- Scheduled for floor debate on 10/15/20.
- HB82 Amedee STUDENTS
Prohibits a school from sharing a student's personally identifiable information relative to illness or disease with the Dept. of Health for purposes of the Sanitary Code or any other purpose without parental consent (Item #42)
- Reported favorably (11-0).
- Rules suspended.
- Read by title, ordered engrossed, passed to 3rd reading.
- Scheduled for floor debate on 10/15/20.
- HB86 Cormier APPROPRIATIONS/SUPPLEML
Makes supplemental appropriations for Fiscal Year 2020-2021 (Item #11)
- Read third time by title, amended, roll called on final passage, yeas 44, nays 54. Failed to pass.
- HB87 Brown, Chad INSURANCE
Provides relative to emergency powers of the commissioner of insurance (Items #2, 28, and 29)
- Involuntarily deferred in committee.
- HB89 James TAX/INCOME TAX
Modifies the definition of "federal income tax liability" to include certain federal net disaster losses (Item #26)
- Read third time by title, roll called on final passage, yeas 99, nays 0. Finally passed, title adopted, ordered to the Senate.
- HB93 Willard EMPLOYMENT
Creates a work-sharing program (Item #8)
- Read third time by title, amended, roll called on final passage, yeas 99, nays 0. Finally passed, title adopted, ordered to the Senate.
- HB95 Butler EXCEP PERSON/DEV DISABLE
Requires the La. Department of Health to allow visitation of residents at intermediate care facilities by

- HCR24 Romero AGRICULTURE
Memorializes Congress and the Louisiana congressional delegation to take such actions as necessary to fully fund the Livestock Indemnity Program in response to the negative impact created by losses to the Louisiana livestock industry as a result of Hurricane Laura and Hurricane Delta
- Read by title, amended, roll called on final consideration, yeas 102, nays 0. The resolution was adopted and ordered to the Senate.
- HCR29 Butler EXCEP PERSON/DEV DISABLE
Amends administrative rules regarding leave of absence days for clients of intermediate care facilities (Items #28 and 29)
- Reported with amendments (15-0).
- Rules suspended.
- Read by title, amended, ordered engrossed, passed to 3rd reading.
- Scheduled for floor debate on 10/15/20.
- HCR30 Landry CONGRESS
Memorializes congress and the Louisiana congressional delegation to take such actions as are necessary to pass a stimulus plan that includes funds for unemployment, housing, and local government
- Read by title, rules suspended, referred to the Committee on Appropriations.
- HCR31 Lyons PURCHASING/PROCUREMENT CD
To urge and request agencies procuring supplies, services, and major repairs on an emergency basis to provide for greater transparency and competition in such procurements where practicable
- Read by title, rules suspended, referred to the Committee on Transportation, Highways and Public Works.
- HCSR1 Deshotel TAX CREDITS
Requests the House Ways and Means and Senate Revenue and Fiscal Affairs Committees to study the feasibility of establishing tax incentives for broadband providers that provide coverage to rural unserved areas in Louisiana
- Sent to the Senate.
- HCSR2 Landry LEGISLATIVE AFFAIRS
Requests the Committee on House and Governmental Affairs and the Committee on Senate and Governmental Affairs to study the compensation allocated to each member for legislative assistants and make recommendations relative thereto
- Sent to the Senate.
- HR1 Echols HEALTH CARE
Requests a study of the costs and benefits of setting Medicaid reimbursement rates for primary care services equivalent to Medicare rates for those services
- Enrolled and signed by the Speaker of the House.
- HR2 Duplessis ELECTIONS/COMMISSIONERS
Requests the clerks of court to develop and utilize innovative strategies to recruit commissioners for polling places
- Enrolled and signed by the Speaker of the House.
- HR8 Thompson COMMENDATIONS

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- Commends Richard "Ricky" Thomas for his business, civic, and philanthropic service to the state of Louisiana and its citizens

- HR21 Jenkins COMMENDATIONS

- HSR2 Landry HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
Requests the Committee on House and Governmental Affairs to study issues surrounding providing paid family leave to employees of the House of Representatives

- SB1 Ward TAX/AD VALOREM
Extends the carryforward period for the inventory tax credit for certain businesses. (1/1/21) (Items #26 and #65)
- Read third time by title, roll called on final passage, yeas 95, nays 0. Finally passed, ordered to the Senate.
- SB5 Hewitt PORTS/HARBORS/TERMINALS
Authorizes Plaquemines Port, Harbor and Terminal District to apply for designation as a foreign trade zone. (gov sig) (Item #47)
- Received in the House from the Senate, rules suspended, read by title, referred to the Committee on Transportation, Highways and Public Works.
- SB11 Cathey SCHOOLS
Prohibits certain schools from being members of any interscholastic extracurricular athletic association or organization that does not have certain persons as members of its executive committee. (gov sig) (Item #42)
- Reported with amendments (12-0). Referred to the Legislative Bureau.
 - Reported without Legislative Bureau amendments.
 - Rules suspended.
 - Read by title, amended, passed to 3rd reading.
 - Scheduled for floor debate on 10/15/20.
- SB12 Mills, Robert HEALTH CARE
Provides access for patients of hospitals and residents of nursing homes, assisted living facilities, and other adult residential care homes to members of the clergy who volunteer to minister and provide religious sacraments and services, counseling, and mental health support during COVID-19 and other public health emergencies. (gov sig) (Item #28)
- Received in the House from the Senate, rules suspended, read by title, referred to the Committee on Health and Welfare.
- SB15 Milligan SCHOOLS
Requires first-day health insurance coverage for employees of public elementary and secondary school systems under certain circumstances. (gov sig) (Item #42)
- Received in the House from the Senate, rules suspended, read by title, referred to the Committee

SB38	White, B	FUNDS/FUNDING	Provides relative to the creation, use, dedication, and transfer of funds in the state treasury. (gov sig) (Item #16) <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Received in the House from the Senate, rules suspended, read by title, referred to the Committee on Appropriations.
SB39	Hewitt	LEGIS POWERS/FUNCTIONS	Provides for remote operations of the legislature during a gubernatorially declared state of emergency. (gov sig) (Item #25) <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Reported favorably (9-0-1). Referred to the Legislative Bureau.- Reported without Legislative Bureau amendments.- Rules suspended.- Read by title, passed to 3rd reading.- Scheduled for floor debate on 10/15/20.
SB42	Bouie	SCHOOLS	Provides for the duties of the local school superintendent when certain schools in the Recovery School District are returned to the transferring school board. (gov sig) (Item #42) <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Involuntarily deferred in committee.
SB44	Fields	COLLEGES/UNIVERSITIES	Constitutional amendment to authorize the governor to appoint persons who reside out-of-state as certain at-large members of public postsecondary education boards of supervisors. (2/3 - CA13s1(A)) (Item #42) <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Reported with amendments (9-0). Referred to the Legislative Bureau.
SB45	Fields	COLLEGES/UNIVERSITIES	Provides for the "Lod Cook Act" which authorizes the governor to appoint persons who reside out-of-state at certain at-large members of the public postsecondary boards of supervisors. (See Act) (Item #42) <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Reported with amendments (9-0). Referred to the Legislative Bureau.- Reported without Legislative Bureau amendments.- Rules suspended.- Read by title, amended, passed to 3rd reading.- Scheduled for floor debate on 10/15/20.

Referred to the Legislative Bureau.- Reported without Legislative Bureau amendments.- Rules suspended.- Read by title, passed to 3rd reading.- Scheduled for floor debate on 10/15/20.
SB71	Peacock	PUBLIC MEETINGS	Provides for participation in certain meetings by teleconferencing or other electronic means for legislative bodies. (gov sig) (Item #25) <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Received in the House from the Senate, rules suspended, read by title, referred to the Committee on House and Governmental Affairs.
SB72	Talbot	TAX/INCOME/CORPORATE	Authorizes an income tax credit for certain businesses whose operations were interrupted as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic. (gov sig) (Items #26 and #65) <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Received in the House from the Senate, rules suspended, read by title, referred to the Committee on Ways and Means.
SCR2	Fields	COLLEGES/UNIVERSITIES	Requests LCTCS and Sowela administrators to work together to study the impacts of hurricanes Laura and Delta on the institution and its student body in order to inform any legislative requests for the 2021 Regular Session. <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Reported favorably (12-0).- Rules suspended.- Read by title, passed to 3rd reading.- Scheduled for floor debate on 10/15/20.

SCR9 Cortez UNEMPLOYMENT COMP
