- SB1            Ward                            TAX/AD VALOREM  
Extends the carryforward period for the inventory tax credit for certain businesses. (1/1/21) (Items #26 and #65)  
- Introduced in the Senate; read by title. Rules suspended. Read second time and referred to the Committee on Revenue and Fiscal Affairs.
- SB2            Cathey                            TAX EXEMPTIONS  
Exempts purchases of utilities by commercial farmers and agricultural manufacturers impacted by a declared state of emergency or disaster from state sales and use tax. (gov sig) (Item #26)  
- Introduced in the Senate; read by title. Rules suspended. Read second time and referred to the Committee on Revenue and Fiscal Affairs.
- SB3            Cathey                            TAX EXEMPTIONS  
Exempts business utilities from state sales tax for businesses impacted by 2020 states of disaster or emergency. (gov sig) (Item #26)  
- Introduced in the Senate; read by title. Rules suspended. Read second time and referred to the Committee on Revenue and Fiscal Affairs.
- SB4            Cathey                            TAX EXEMPTIONS  
Exempts purchases of certain farm equipment from the state sales and use tax during a declared state of emergency or disaster. (gov sig) (Item #26)  
- Introduced in the Senate; read by title. Rules suspended. Read second time and referred to the Committee on Revenue and Fiscal Affairs.
- SB5            Hewitt                            PORTS/HARBORS/TERMINALS  
Authorizes Plaquemines Port, Harbor and Terminal District to apply for designation as a foreign trade zone. (See CA3s19) (Item #47)  
- Introduced in the Senate; read by title. Rules suspended. Read second time and referred to the Committee on Transportation, Highways and Public Works.
- SB6            Lambert                            CAPITAL OUTLAY  
Provides for capital outlay requests for a state-owned and administered project submitted by a budget unit of the state. (gov sig) (2/3-CA7s11(C)) (Item #15)  
- Introduced in the Senate; read by title. Rules suspended. Read second time and referred to the Committee on Revenue and Fiscal Affairs.
- SB7            Hewitt                            PORTS/HARBORS/TERMINALS  
Provides relative to the Louisiana International Deep Water Gulf Transfer Terminal Authority. (1/1/21) (Item #50)  
- Introduced in the Senate; read by title. Rules suspended. Read second time and referred to the Committee on Transportation, Highways and Public Works.
- SB8            Cathey                            TAX EXEMPTIONS  
Exempts purchases of utilities by businesses in the parishes impacted by Hurricane Laura from state sales and use tax. (gov sig) (Item #26)  
- Introduced in the Senate; read by title. Rules suspended. Read second time and referred to the Committee on Revenue and Fiscal Affairs.
- SB9            Cathey                            TAX EXEMPTIONS  
Exempts purchases of construction materials from state sales and use tax in parishes impacted by certain disasters. (gov sig) (Item #26)  
- Introduced in the Senate; read by title. Rules suspended. Read second time and referred to the Committee on Revenue and Fiscal Affairs.

- SB19 Talbot FEES/LICENSES/PERMITS  
Provides an exemption to certain permit fees collected by the Office of Alcohol and Tobacco Control. (gov sig) (Item #35)  
- Introduced in the Senate; read by title. Rules suspended. Read second time and referred to the Committee on Judiciary B.
- SB20 Hewitt EMERGENCY POWERS  
Provides relative to voting and the holding of elections impaired as the result of a declared emergency or disaster. (1/1/21) (Item #5)  
- Introduced in the Senate; read by title. Rules suspended. Read second time and referred to the Committee on Senate and Governmental Affairs.
- SB21 Hewitt CIVIL SERVICE DEPARTMENT  
Provides for revisions to the fee structure and oversight of the in-service training and educational programs for state employees by the Department of State Civil Service. (1/1/21) (Item #52)  
- Introduced in the Senate; read by title. Rules suspended. Read second time and referred to the Committee on Senate and Governmental Affairs.
- SB22 Hewitt VOTERS/VOTING  
Provides for preparation and counting of absentee and early voting ballots. (gov sig) (Item #5)  
- Introduced in the Senate; read by title. Rules suspended. Read second time and referred to the Committee on Senate and Governmental Affairs.
- SB23 McMath SCHOOLS  
Requires school boards to accept certification of illness from a nurse practitioner or physician assistant when employees use leave due to personal illness. (gov sig) (Item #42)  
- Introduced in the Senate; read by title. Rules suspended. Read second time and referred to the Committee on Education.
- SB24 Talbot FEES/LICENSES/PERMITS  
Provides an exemption to certain fees collected by the Louisiana Department of Health and the office of alcohol and tobacco control. (gov sig) (Item #32)  
- Introduced in the Senate; read by title. Rules suspended. Read second time and referred to the Committee on Judiciary B.
- SB25 Allain ENVIRONMENTAL CONTROL  
Provides for the transfer and use of funds from the Louisiana Main Street Recovery Program to the Oilfield Site Restoration Fund. (gov sig) (Item #19)  
- Introduced in the Senate; read by title. Rules suspended. Read second time and referred to the Committee on Finance.
- SB26 Peterson LOCAL EMPLOYEES  
Removes employees of the Regional Transit Authority from the state system and state civil service. (gov sig) (Item #62)  
- Introduced in the Senate; read by title. Rules suspended. Read second time and referred to the Committee on Retirement.
- SB27 Peacock HEALTH CARE  
Provides relative to the practice of medicine. (2/3 - CA7s2.1(A)) (7/1/21) (Item #45)  
- Introduced in the Senate; read by title. Rules suspended. Read second time and referred to the
