Chamber: Senate

- SB6 Lambert CAPITAL OUTLAY
Provides for capital outlay requests for a state-owned and administered project submitted by a budget unit of the state. (gov sig) (2/3 - CA7s11(C)) (Item #15)
- Reported with amendments. Rules suspended. Read by title; Committee amendments read and adopted. Ordered engrossed and passed to third reading and final passage.
- SB14 Johns TAX/TAXATION
Expands the Louisiana New Markets Jobs Act tax credit to certain recovery zones. (gov sig) (Item #65)
- Reported favorably. Rules suspended. Read by title; ordered engrossed and passed to third reading and final passage.
- SB29 Cortez EMERGENCY POWERS
Provides for legislative review of a state of emergency issued by the governor that extends beyond thirty days. (gov sig) (Items #1 and #2)
- Reported favorably. Rules suspended. Read by title; ordered engrossed and passed to third reading and final passage.
- SB31 Fields EDUCATION ACCOUNTABILITY
Prohibits use of statewide student assessments conducted during the 2020-2021 school year for the purposes of evaluating teacher performance, making student placement decisions, or calculating school and district performance scores and letter grades. (gov sig) (Item #42)
- Introduced in the Senate; read by title. Rules suspended. Read second time and referred to the Committee on Education.
- SB32 Fields COLLEGES/UNIVERSITIES
Grants certain operational autonomies to certain public postsecondary education institutions (gov sig) (Item #42)
- Introduced in the Senate; read by title. Rules suspended. Read second time and referred to the Committee on Education.
- SB33 Foil CORPORATIONS
Provides for revisions for Business Corporation Act relative to virtual shareholder meetings and mergers. (gov sig) (Item #53)
- Introduced in the Senate; read by title. Rules suspended. Read second time and referred to the Committee on Commerce, Consumer Protection and International Affairs.
- SB34 Peacock SPEECH/PATH/AUDIO
Provides for the Audiology and Speech-Language Pathology Interstate Compact (ASLP-IC). (7/1/21) (Item #37)
- Introduced in the Senate; read by title. Rules suspended. Read second time and referred to the Committee on Health and Welfare.
- SB35 Fields GOVERNOR
Requires that the termination of a gubernatorially declared state of disaster or emergency be approved by two-thirds of the membership of both houses. (1/1/21) (Item #2)
- Read by title; withdrawn from the files of the Senate.
- SB36 Fields TOPS
Provides relative to qualifications for Taylor Opportunity Program for Students scholarships. (gov sig) (Item #43)
- Introduced in the Senate; read by title. Rules suspended. Read second time and referred to the

- SB37 White, B CAPITAL OUTLAY
To provide relative to the capital outlay process. (gov sig) (Item #15)
- Introduced in the Senate; read by title. Rules suspended. Read second time and referred to the Committee on Transportation, Highways and Public Works.
- SB38 White, B FUNDS/FUNDING
Provides relative to the creation, use, dedication, and transfer of funds in the state treasury. (gov sig) (Item #16)
- Introduced in the Senate; read by title. Rules suspended. Read second time and referred to the Committee on Finance.
- SB39 Hewitt LEGIS POWERS/FUNCTIONS
Provides for remote operations of the legislature during a gubernatorially declared state of emergency. (gov sig) (Item #25)
- Rules suspended. Introduced in the Senate; read by title. Rules suspended. Read second time and referred to the Committee on Senate and Governmental Affairs.
- SB40 Hewitt LEGIS POWERS/FUNCTIONS
Constitutional Amendment to provide for remote operations of the legislature during a declared emergency. (2/3 - CA13s1(A)) (Item #5)
- Rules suspended. Introduced in the Senate; read by title. Rules suspended. Read second time and referred to the Committee on Senate and Governmental Affairs.
- SCR1 Foil CONDOLENCES
Expresses condolences upon the death of Frank Leonard.
- Read by title and adopted by a vote of 34 yeas and 0 nays. Ordered sent to the House.
- SR3 Fields CONDOLENCES
Expresses sincere and heartfelt condolences of the Senate of the Legislature of Louisiana upon the death of James Michell "Jimmy" Bernhard.
- Read by title and adopted.
- SR4 Boudreaux COMMENDATIONS
Commends Dr. Kim Hunter Reed on being chosen as the recipient of the State Higher Education Executive Officers Association's (SHEEO) 2020 Exceptional Leader Award.
- Introduced in the Senate. Read by title and placed on the Calendar for a second reading.
- SR5 Bernard CONDOLENCES
Expresses condolences on the death of Philip and Pauline Ackel.
- Rules suspended. Introduced in the Senate. Read by title and placed on the Calendar for a second reading.
