SB11	Cathey	SCHOOLS	Prohibits certain schools from being members of any interscholastic extracurricular athletic association or organization that does not have certain persons as members of its executive committee. (gov sig) (Item #42) - Read by title, passed by a vote of 30 yeas and 4 nays, and sent to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.
SB26	Peterson	LOCAL EMPLOYEES	Removes employees of the Regional Transit Authority from the state system and state civil service. (gov sig) (Item #62) - Reported with amendments. Rules suspended. SB29	Cortez	EMERGENCY POWERS	Provides for legislative review of a state of emergency issued by the governor that extends beyond thirty days. (gov sig) (Items #1 and #2) - Received from the House with amendments.
SB32	Fields	COLLEGES/UNIVERSITIES	Grants certain operational autonomies to certain public postsecondary education institutions. (gov sig) (Item #42) - Senate floor amendments read and adopted. Read by title and passed by a vote of 34 yeas and 0 nays; ordered reengrossed and sent to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.
SB39	Hewitt	LEGIS POWERS/FUNCTIONS	Provides for remote operations of the legislature during a gubernatorially declared state of emergency. (gov sig) (Item #25) - Reconsidered. Read by title; returned to the Calendar, subject to call.
SB50	Allain	CAPITAL OUTLAY	Provides relative to the capital outlay process. (gov sig) (Item #15) - Reported with amendments. Rules suspended. Read by title; Committee amendments read and adopted. Ordered engrossed and passed to third reading and final passage.
