- SB1 Ward TAX/AD VALOREM
Extends the carryforward period for the inventory tax credit for certain businesses. (1/1/21) (Items #26 and #65)
- Read by title, passed by a vote of 35 yeas and 0 nays, and sent to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.
- SB18 Cathey FEES/LICENSES/PERMITS
Provides an exemption to certain permit fees collected by the Office of Alcohol and Tobacco Control. (gov sig) (Item #35)
- Reported with amendments. Rules suspended. Read by title; Committee amendments read and adopted. Ordered engrossed and passed to third reading and final passage.
- SB24 Talbot FEES/LICENSES/PERMITS
Provides an exemption to certain fees collected by the Louisiana Department of Health and the office of alcohol and tobacco control. (gov sig) (Item #32)
- Reported with amendments. Rules suspended, read by title, committee amendments read and adopted. Ordered engrossed and recommitted to the committee on Revenue and Fiscal Affairs.
- SB25 Allain ENVIRONMENTAL CONTROL
Provides for the transfer and use of funds from the Louisiana Main Street Recovery Program to the Oilfield Site Restoration Fund. (gov sig) (Item #19)
- Reported with amendments. Rules suspended. Read by title; Committee amendments read and adopted. Ordered engrossed and passed to third reading and final passage.
- SB26 Peterson LOCAL EMPLOYEES
Removes employees of the Regional Transit Authority from the state system and state civil service. (gov sig) (Item #62)
- Read by title, passed by a vote of 35 yeas and 0 nays, and sent to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.
- SB29 Cortez EMERGENCY POWERS
Provides for legislative review of a state of emergency issued by the governor that extends beyond thirty days. (gov sig) (Items #1 and #2)
- Amendments proposed by the House read and rejected by a vote of 34 yeas and 0 nays.
- SB37 White, B CAPITAL OUTLAY
To provide relative to the capital outlay process. (gov sig) (Item #15)
- Reported with amendments. Rules suspended. Read by title; Committee amendments read and adopted. Ordered engrossed and passed to third reading and final passage.
- SB39 Hewitt LEGIS POWERS/FUNCTIONS
Provides for remote operations of the legislature during a gubernatorially declared state of emergency. (gov sig) (Item #25)
- Called from the Calendar.
- Read by title, passed by a vote of 32 yeas and 0 nays, and sent to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.
- SB40 Hewitt LEGIS POWERS/FUNCTIONS
Constitutional Amendment to provide for remote operations of the legislature during a declared emergency. (2/3 - CA13s1(A)) (Item #5)
- Called from the Calendar.
- Senate floor amendments read and adopted. Read by title. By a vote of 25 yeas and 7 nays, the

- SB67 Reese ECONOMIC DEVELOP DEPT
Authorizes the Department of Economic Development to provide an extension for certain job creation requirements for enterprise zone incentives and quality jobs incentive rebates due to the impacts of COVID-19 and Hurricane Laura. (gov sig) (Items #26 and #65)
- Introduced in the Senate; read by title. Rules suspended. Read second time and referred to the Committee on Commerce, Consumer Protection and International Affairs.
- SB68 Luneau EMPLOYMENT
Provides for definitions of employee and independent contractor. (1/1/21) (Item #24)
- Introduced in the Senate; read by title. Rules suspended. Read second time and referred to the Committee on Labor and Industrial Relations.
- SB69 Johns EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS
Provides relative to emergency service plans of certain providers. (gov sig) (2/3-CA7s2.1(A)) (Items #2 and #38)
- Introduced in the Senate; read by title. Rules suspended. Read second time and referred to the Committee on Commerce, Consumer Protection and International Affairs.
- SB70 Jackson LEGIS POWERS/FUNCTIONS
Provides for legislative approval of BESE adopted adjustments to the MFP formula by ballot when the legislature is not in session. (gov sig) (Item #4)
- Rules suspended. Introduced in the Senate; read by title. Rules suspended. Read second time and referred to the Committee on Education.
- SCR5 Reese EMPLOYMENT
Suspends certain provisions of law relative to unemployment tax increases and benefit reductions. (Items #8 and #30).
- Reported with amendments. Rules suspended, read by title, committee amendments read and adopted. Ordered engrossed and recommitted to the committee on Retirement.
- Reported with amendments. Rules suspended, read by title, committee amendments read and adopted. Ordered engrossed and recommitted to the committee on Revenue and Fiscal Affairs.
- SCR7 Peacock CONDOLENCES
Expresses sincere condolences upon the death of Sister Joan Martinette Rivers, OLS.
- Received from the House without amendments.
- SCR9 Cortez UNEMPLOYMENT COMP
Suspends the provision of law providing for an unemployment insurance solvency tax. (Item #8 and #30)
- Reported favorably. Rules suspended. Read by title; ordered engrossed and recommitted to the Committee on Revenue and Fiscal Affairs.
- SCR10 Foil LEGISLATIVE AGENCIES
Requests that the Louisiana State Law Institute study certain matters pertaining to the Louisiana Trust Code.
- Reported with amendments.
