- HB8 Johnson, Mike REAPPORTIONMENT/JUDGES
Provides for the districts for election of the justices of the Supreme Court (Item #3)
- Read by title, returned to the calendar.
- Called from the calendar.
- Read third time by title, roll called on final passage, yeas 94, nays 10. The bill, having received two-thirds vote of the elected members, was finally passed, title adopted, ordered to the Senate.
- HB14 Echols REAPPORTIONMENT/CONGRESS
Provides relative to the election districts for members of congress (Item #1)
- Reported favorably (11-6. To be recommitted to the Committee on Appropriations.
- Rules suspended.
- Read by title, ordered engrossed, passed to 3rd reading.
- Scheduled for floor debate on 01/18/2024.
- HB16 McFarland APPROPRIATIONS/SUPPLEML
To make supplemental appropriations for the 2023-2024 Fiscal Year (Items #6, #11, and #14)
- Read third time by title, amended, roll called on final passage, yeas 96, nays 8. Finally passed, title adopted, ordered to the Senate.
- HB17 Emerson ELECTIONS
Provides for closed party primary elections for certain offices (Items #7, #8, and #10)
- Read third time by title, amended, roll called on final passage, yeas 64, nays 40. Finally passed, title adopted, ordered to the Senate.
- HB19 Beaulieu REAPPORTIONMENT/CONGRESS
Provides relative to the election districts for members of congress (Item #1)
- Read by title, rules suspended, referred to the Committee on House and Governmental Affairs.
- SB8 Womack CONGRESS
Provides for redistricting of Louisiana congressional districts. (Item #1)(See Act)
- Received in the House from the Senate, rules suspended, read by title, referred to the Committee on House and Governmental Affairs.
