Constitutional Amendment to increase the composition of the Louisiana Supreme Court. (Items #4, 5, and 13)(2/3 - CA13s1(A))
- Prefiled and under the rules provisionally referred to the Committee on Senate and Governmental Affairs.
- Introduced in the Senate; read by title. Rules suspended. Read second time and referred to the Committee on Senate and Governmental Affairs.
- SB7 Seabaugh COURTS
Redistricts the Louisiana Supreme Court to increase the composition of the court from seven to nine justices. (2/3 - CA5s4)(Item #3)(See Act)
- Introduced in the Senate; read by title. Rules suspended. Read second time and referred to the Committee on Senate and Governmental Affairs.
- SB8 Womack CONGRESS
Provides for redistricting of Louisiana congressional districts. (Item #1)(See Act)

SCR1 Barrow LEGISLATIVE SESSIONS
Invites the governor to address a joint session of the legislature on Monday, January 15, 2024, at 4:30 pm.

- Introduced in the Senate; read by title. Rules suspended. Read second time by title and adopted by a vote of 38 yeas and 0 nays. Ordered sent to the House.

- Received from the House without amendments.

SR1 Barrow LEGISLATIVE SESSIONS
Resolves that a committee be appointed to notify the House of Representatives that the Senate has convened and organized and is prepared to transact business.

- Introduced in the Senate; read by title. Rules suspended. Read second time by title and adopted.

SR2 Barrow LEGISLATIVE SESSIONS
Resolves that a committee be appointed to act with a similar house committee to notify the governor that the legislature has convened and organized and is prepared to receive his communications.

- Introduced in the Senate; read by title. Rules suspended. Read second time by title and adopted.
