To be recommitted to the Committee on Civil Law and Procedure. - Rules suspended. - Read by title, amended, ordered engrossed, recommitted to the Committee on Civil Law and Procedure. - Reported without amendments (11-3). - Rules suspended. - Read by title, passed to 3rd reading. - Scheduled for floor debate on 11/12/2024.

HB21 Bourriaque TAX/SALES & USE
Requires the secretary of the Department of Revenue to annually estimate revenue derived from aviation fuel collections (Items #8 and 11)
- Reported favorably (15-0).

HB22 Wilder TAX/GAMING
Provides for taxation of sports wagering (Items #11 and #13)
- Read by title, under the rules, referred to the Committee on Ways and Means.

HB23 Geymann MINERALS
Provides for the administration of the Oilfield Site Restoration Fund (Item #16)
- Read by title. Lies over under the rules.

HB24 Geymann MINERALS/MINERAL BOARD
Provides for the leasing of state property for energy-related purposes (Item #17)
- Read by title. Lies over under the rules.

HB25 Riser TAX/SEVERANCE TAX
Provides relative to severance tax on oil and gas and for dedication of certain severance tax revenues (Item #9)
