HB1	Emerson	TAX/INCOME TAX	<p>Provides for a flat rate for purposes of calculating income tax for individuals, estates, and trusts, increases the standard deduction, and modifies or repeals certain income tax deductions and credits (Item #5 and 6)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Read third time by title, amended, roll called on final passage, yeas 87, nays 12. The bill, having received two-thirds vote of the elected members, was finally passed, title adopted, ordered to the Senate.
HB2	Emerson	TAX/CORP INCOME	<p>Provides for a flat rate for purposes of calculating corporate income tax and terminates certain corporate income tax exemptions, deductions, and credits (Item #4)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Read by title, ordered engrossed, passed to 3rd reading.- Scheduled for floor debate on 11/13/2024.
HB3	Emerson	TAX/CORP FRANCHISE	<p>Repeals the corporation franchise tax and limits eligibility of certain credits to be claimed against corporation franchise tax (Item #3)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Read by title, returned to the calendar.- Called from the calendar.- Read third time by title, amended, roll called on final passage, yeas 83, nays 14. Finally passed, title adopted, ordered to the Senate.
HB4	McFarland	APPROPRIATIONS/SUPPLEML	<p>Makes supplemental appropriations for Fiscal Year 2024-2025 (Items #18, 21, and 23)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Read third time by title, roll called on final passage, yeas 99, nays 0. Finally passed, title adopted, ordered to the Senate.
HB5	Bacala	TEACHERS/SALARY	<p>Requires school systems to provide a salary increase for teachers and other school employees using savings attributable to the state's payment of certain unfunded accrued liability of the Teachers' Retirement System of Louisiana (Item #2)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Reported with amendments (12-0).- Rules suspended.- Read by title, amended, ordered engrossed, recommitted to the Committee on Appropriations.
HB7	Emerson	FUNDS/FUNDING	<p>(Constitutional Amendment) Revises Article VII of the Constitution of La. (Items #1, 2, 7, and 14)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Read third time by title, amended, roll called on final passage, yeas 81, nays 15. The bill, having received two-thirds vote of the elected members, was finally passed, title adopted, ordered to the Senate.
HB8	Brass	TAX/SALES & USE	<p>Levies sales and use taxes on certain digital products and services (Items #8 and 13)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Read by title, amended, ordered engrossed, passed to 3rd reading.- Scheduled for floor debate on 11/13/2024.
HB11	Deshotel	TAX/AD VALOREM TAX	<p>Provides for the homestead exemption, special assessment level, and other property tax exemptions for purposes of determining ad valorem taxation of certain property (Items #1 and 10)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Read third time by title, amended, roll called on final passage, yeas 80, nays 16. Finally passed, title adopted, ordered to the Senate.
