HB2	Emerson	TAX/CORP INCOME	<p>Provides for a flat rate for purposes of calculating corporate income tax and terminates certain corporate income tax exemptions, deductions, and credits (Item #4)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Read by title, returned to the calendar.- Called from the calendar.- Read third time by title, amended, roll called on final passage, yeas 79, nays 19. The bill, having received two-thirds vote of the elected members, was finally passed, title adopted, ordered to the Senate.
HB5	Bacala	TEACHERS/SALARY	<p>Requires school systems to provide a salary increase for teachers and other school employees using savings attributable to the state's payment of certain unfunded accrued liability of the Teachers' Retirement System of Louisiana (Item #2)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Reported favorably (23-0).- Rules suspended.- Read by title, passed to 3rd reading.- Scheduled for floor debate on 11/14/2024.
HB6	Beaullieu	ELECTIONS/SPECIAL	<p>Calls a special statewide election on March 29, 2025, for submitting proposed constitutional amendments to the state's electors (Item #22)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Reported favorably (12-0). To be recommitted to the Committee on Appropriations.- Rules suspended.- Read by title, ordered engrossed, recommitted to the Committee on Appropriations.- Reported favorably (21-0).- Rules suspended.- Read by title, passed to 3rd reading.- Scheduled for floor debate on 11/14/2024.
HB8	Brass	TAX/SALES & USE	<p>Levies sales and use taxes on certain digital products and services (Items #8 and 13)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Read third time by title, amended, roll called on final passage, yeas 80, nays 19. The bill, having received two-thirds vote of the elected members, was finally passed, title adopted, ordered to the Senate.
HB9	Riser	TAX/SALES & USE	<p>Provides for sales and use tax on certain services (Items #8 and 13)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Reported with amendments (16-2). To be recommitted to the Committee on Appropriations.- Rules suspended.- Read by title, amended, ordered engrossed, recommitted to the Committee on Appropriations.- Reported favorably (17-6).- Rules suspended.- Read by title, passed to 3rd reading.- Scheduled for floor debate on 11/14/2024.
HB10	Wright	TAX/SALES & USE	<p>Provides for the rate of the state sales and use tax and provides for the exemptions, exclusions, credits, and rebates claimed against sales and use taxes (Item #8)</p>
