HB5	Bacala	TEACHERS/SALARY	Requires school systems to provide a salary increase for teachers and other school employees using savings attributable to the state's payment of certain unfunded accrued liability of the Teachers' Retirement System of Louisiana (Item #2) <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Read third time by title, amended, roll called on final passage, yeas 99, nays 0. Finally passed, title adopted, ordered to the Senate.
HB6	Beaullieu	ELECTIONS/SPECIAL	Calls a special statewide election on March 29, 2025, for submitting proposed constitutional amendments to the state's electors (Item #22) <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Read third time by title, roll called on final passage, yeas 97, nays 0. Finally passed, title adopted, ordered to the Senate.
HB9	Riser	TAX/SALES & USE	Provides for sales and use tax on certain services (Items #8 and 13) <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Read by title, returned to the calendar.
HB10	Wright	TAX/SALES & USE	Provides for the rate of the state sales and use tax and provides for the exemptions, exclusions, credits, and rebates claimed against sales and use taxes (Item #8) <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Read by title, returned to the calendar.- Called from the calendar.- Read third time by title, amended, roll called on final passage, yeas 71, nays 23. The bill, having received two-thirds vote of the elected members, was finally passed, title adopted, ordered to the Senate.
HB23	Geymann	MINERALS	Provides for the administration of the Oilfield Site Restoration Fund (Item #16) <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Read third time by title, amended, roll called on final passage, yeas 100, nays 0. The bill, having received two-thirds vote of the elected members, was finally passed, title adopted, ordered to the Senate.
HB24	Geymann	MINERALS/MINERAL BOARD	Provides for the leasing of state property for energy-related purposes (Item #17) <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Read third time by title, roll called on final passage, yeas 100, nays 0. The bill, having received two-thirds vote of the elected members, was finally passed, title adopted, ordered to the Senate.
HB25	Riser	TAX/SEVERANCE TAX	Provides relative to severance tax on oil and gas and for dedication of certain severance tax revenues (Item #9) <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Read third time by title, amended, roll called on final passage, yeas 100, nays 0. The bill, having received two-thirds vote of the elected members, was finally passed, title adopted, ordered to the Senate.
SB1	Morris, Jay	COURTS	Constitutional amendment to provide for jurisdiction of courts. (2/3 - CA13s1(A)) (Item #20) <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Received in the House from the Senate.- Read by title, rules suspended, referred to the Committee on Judiciary.
