Provides for the leasing of state property for energy-related purposes (Item #17)
- Read by title, roll called, yeas 97, nays 0. The Senate amendments, having received two-thirds vote of the elected members, were concurred in.

- SB1 Morris, Jay COURTS
Constitutional amendment to provide for jurisdiction of courts. (2/3 - CA13s1(A)) (Item #20)
- Scheduled for floor debate on 11/22/2024.
- SB2 Cloud JUVENILE JUSTICE
Constitutional amendment to provide relative to offenses to which special juvenile procedures are not applicable. (2/3 - CA13s1(A)) (Item #19)
- Scheduled for floor debate on 11/22/2024.
- SB5 Morris, Jay COURTS
Constitutional amendment to provide for elections to fill newly-created judgeships and judicial vacancies and for exceptions as to courts of limited or specialized jurisdictions. (2/3 - CA13s1(A)) (Item #20)
- Scheduled for floor debate on 11/22/2024.
- SB9 Miller, G. CIVIL PROCEDURE
Provides for legislative continuances and extensions of time for legislators and legislative employees. (Item #20) (gov sig)
- Rules suspended, called out of its regular order.
 - Read third time by title, amended, roll called on final passage, yeas 97, nays 0. Finally passed, ordered to the Senate.
