The Senate amendments, having received two-thirds vote of the elected members, were concurred in.

HB5	Bacala	TEACHERS/SALARY	Requires school systems to provide a salary increase for teachers and other school employees using savings attributable to the state's payment of certain unfunded accrued liability of the Teachers' Retirement System of Louisiana (Item #2) <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Received from the Senate with amendments.- Rules suspended.- Read by title, roll called, yeas 101, nays 0, Senate amendments concurred in.
HB6	Beaullieu	ELECTIONS/SPECIAL	Calls a special statewide election on March 29, 2025, for submitting proposed constitutional amendments to the state's electors (Item #22) <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Received from the Senate without amendments.
HB7	Emerson	FUNDS/FUNDING	(Constitutional Amendment) Revises Article VII of the Constitution of La. (Items #1, 2, 7, and 14) <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Received from the Senate with amendments.- Rules suspended.- Read by title, roll called, yeas 87, nays 11. The Senate amendments, having received two-thirds vote of the elected members, were concurred in.
HB8	Brass	TAX/SALES & USE	Levies sales and use taxes on certain digital products and services (Items #8 and 13) <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Received from the Senate with amendments.- Rules suspended.- Read by title, roll called, yeas 81, nays 18. The Senate amendments, having received two-thirds vote of the elected members, were concurred in.
HB10	Wright	TAX/SALES & USE	Provides for the rate of the state sales and use tax and provides for the exemptions, exclusions, credits, and rebates claimed against sales and use taxes (Item #8) <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Received from the Senate with amendments.

Provides for the administration of the Oilfield Site Restoration Fund (Item #16)

HB24 Geymann MINERALS/MINERAL BOARD
Provides for the leasing of state property for energy-related purposes (Item #17)

- Sent to the Governor for executive approval.

HB25 Riser TAX/SEVERANCE TAX
Provides relative to severance tax on oil and gas and for dedication of certain severance tax revenues (Item #9)

- Received from the Senate with amendments.

- Rules suspended.

- Read by title, roll called, yeas 101, nays 0, Senate amendments concurred in.

SB1 Morris, Jay COURTS
Constitutional amendment to provide for jurisdiction of courts. (2/3 - CA13s1(A)) (Item #20)

- Read third time by title, amended, roll called on final passage, yeas 73, nays 25. The bill, having received two-thirds vote of the elected members, was finally passed, ordered to the Senate.

SB2 Cloud JUVENILE JUSTICE
Constitutional amendment to provide relative to offenses to which special juvenile procedures are not applicable. (2/3 - CA13s1(A)) (Item #19)

- Read third time by title, amended, roll called on final passage, yeas 70, nays 25. The bill, having
