SB1	Morris, Jay	COURTS	Constitutional amendment to provide for jurisdiction of courts. (2/3 - CA13s1(A)) (Item #20) - Read by title and returned to the Calendar, subject to call.
SB2	Cloud	JUVENILE JUSTICE	Constitutional amendment to provide relative to offenses to which special juvenile procedures are not applicable. (2/3 - CA13s1(A)) (Item #19) - Read by title and returned to the Calendar, subject to call.
SB5	Morris, Jay	COURTS	Constitutional amendment to provide for elections to fill newly-created judgeships and judicial vacancies and for exceptions as to courts of limited or specialized jurisdictions. (2/3 - CA13s1(A)) (Item #20) - Rules suspended. Reported favorably. - Read by title; Committee amendments read and adopted. Ordered reengrossed and passed to third reading and final passage.
SB9	Miller, G.	CIVIL PROCEDURE	Provides for legislative continuances and extensions of time for legislators and legislative employees. (Item #20) (gov sig) - Introduced in the Senate; read by title. Rules suspended. Read second time and referred to the Committee on Judiciary A.
HB1	Emerson	TAX/INCOME TAX	Provides for a flat rate for purposes of calculating income tax for individuals, estates, and trusts, increases the standard deduction, and modifies or repeals certain income tax deductions and credits (Item #5 and 6) - Received in the Senate; read by title Rules suspended. Read second time by title and referred to the Committee on Revenue and Fiscal Affairs.
HB3	Emerson	TAX/CORP FRANCHISE	Repeals the corporation franchise tax and limits eligibility of certain credits to be claimed against corporation franchise tax (Item #3) - Received in the Senate; read by title Rules suspended. Read second time by title and referred to the Committee on Revenue and Fiscal Affairs.
HB4	McFarland	APPROPRIATIONS/SUPPLEML	Makes supplemental appropriations for Fiscal Year 2024-2025 (Items #18, 21, and 23) - Received in the Senate; read by title Rules suspended. Read second time by title and referred to the Committee on Finance.
HB7	Emerson	FUNDS/FUNDING	(Constitutional Amendment) Revises Article VII of the Constitution of La. (Items #1, 2, 7, and 14) - Received in the Senate; read by title Rules suspended. Read second time by title and referred to the Committee on Revenue and Fiscal Affairs.
HB11	Deshotel	TAX/AD VALOREM TAX	Provides for the homestead exemption, special assessment level, and other property tax exemptions for purposes of determining ad valorem taxation of certain property (Items #1 and 10) - Received in the Senate; read by title Rules suspended. Read second time by title and referred to the Committee on Revenue and Fiscal Affairs.
