Read by title and passed by a vote of 30 yeas and 6 nays; ordered reengrossed and sent to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.
SB2	Cloud	JUVENILE JUSTICE	Constitutional amendment to provide relative to offenses to which special juvenile procedures are not applicable. (2/3 - CA13s1(A)) (Item #19) - Called from the Calendar. - Senate floor amendments read and adopted. Read by title and passed by a vote of 28 yeas and 9 nays; ordered reengrossed and sent to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.
SB5	Morris, Jay	COURTS	Constitutional amendment to provide for elections to fill newly-created judgeships and judicial vacancies and for exceptions as to courts of limited or specialized jurisdictions. (2/3 - CA13s1(A)) (Item #20) - Read by title, passed by a vote of 29 yeas and 7 nays, and sent to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.
SB7	Luneau	LEGISLATORS	Provides for legislative continuances and extensions of time for legislators and legislative employees. (Item #20) (gov sig) - Reported with amendments. Rules suspended. Read by title; Committee amendments read and adopted. Ordered engrossed and passed to third reading and final passage.
SB9	Miller, G.	CIVIL PROCEDURE	Provides for legislative continuances and extensions of time for legislators and legislative employees. (Item #20) (gov sig) - Reported with amendments. Rules suspended. Read by title; Committee amendments read and adopted. Ordered engrossed and passed to third reading and final passage.
HB2	Emerson	TAX/CORP INCOME	Provides for a flat rate for purposes of calculating corporate income tax and terminates certain corporate income tax exemptions, deductions, and credits (Item #4) - Received in the Senate; read by title Rules suspended. Read second time by title and referred to the Committee on Revenue and Fiscal Affairs.
HB5	Bacala	TEACHERS/SALARY	Requires school systems to provide a salary increase for teachers and other school employees using savings attributable to the state's payment of certain unfunded accrued liability of the Teachers' Retirement System of Louisiana (Item #2) - Received in the Senate; read by title Rules suspended. Read second time by title and referred to the Committee on Education.
HB6	Beaullieu	ELECTIONS/SPECIAL	Calls a special statewide election on March 29, 2025, for submitting proposed constitutional amendments to the state's electors (Item #22) - Received in the Senate; read by title Rules suspended. Read second time by title and referred to the Committee on Senate and Governmental Affairs.
HB8	Brass	TAX/SALES & USE	Levies sales and use taxes on certain digital products and services (Items #8 and 13)

- HB10 Wright TAX/SALES & USE
Provides for the rate of the state sales and use tax and provides for the exemptions, exclusions, credits, and rebates claimed against sales and use taxes (Item #8)

- HB12 Deshotel FUNDS/FUNDING
Relative to finances of the state (Items #16 and 21)
- Received in the Senate; read by title Rules suspended. Read second time by title and referred to the Committee on Finance.
- HB21 Bourriaque TAX/SALES & USE
Requires the secretary of the Department of Revenue to annually estimate revenue derived from aviation fuel collections (Items #8 and 11)
- Received in the Senate; read by title Rules suspended. Read second time by title and referred to the Committee on Revenue and Fiscal Affairs.
- HB23 Geymann MINERALS
Provides for the administration of the Oilfield Site Restoration Fund (Item #16)
- Received in the Senate; read by title Rules suspended. Read second time by title and referred to the Committee on Natural Resources.
- HB24 Geymann MINERALS/MINERAL BOARD
Provides for the leasing of state property for energy-related purposes (Item #17)
- Received in the Senate; read by title Rules suspended. Read second time by title and referred to the Committee on Natural Resources.
- HB25 Riser TAX/SEVERANCE TAX
Provides relative to severance tax on oil and gas and for dedication of certain severance tax revenues (Item #9)
