HB1	Emerson	TAX/INCOME TAX	Provides for a flat rate for purposes of calculating income tax for individuals, estates, and trusts, increases the standard deduction, and modifies or repeals certain income tax deductions and credits (Item #5 and 6) - Reported with amendments. Rules suspended. Committee amendments read and adopted. Read by title and referred to the Legislative Bureau.
HB2	Emerson	TAX/CORP INCOME	Provides for a flat rate for purposes of calculating corporate income tax and terminates certain corporate income tax exemptions, deductions, and credits (Item #4) - Reported with amendments. Rules suspended. Committee amendments read and adopted. Read by title and referred to the Legislative Bureau.
HB3	Emerson	TAX/CORP FRANCHISE	Repeals the corporation franchise tax and limits eligibility of certain credits to be claimed against corporation franchise tax (Item #3) - Reported favorably. Rules suspended. Read by title and referred to the Legislative Bureau.
HB4	McFarland	APPROPRIATIONS/SUPPLEML	Makes supplemental appropriations for Fiscal Year 2024-2025 (Items #18, 21, and 23) - Reported favorably. Rules suspended. Read by title and referred to the Legislative Bureau.
HB5	Bacala	TEACHERS/SALARY	Requires school systems to provide a salary increase for teachers and other school employees using savings attributable to the state's payment of certain unfunded accrued liability of the Teachers' Retirement System of Louisiana (Item #2) - Reported favorably. Rules suspended. Read by title and referred to the Legislative Bureau.
HB6	Beaullieu	ELECTIONS/SPECIAL	Calls a special statewide election on March 29, 2025, for submitting proposed constitutional amendments to the state's electors (Item #22) - Reported favorably. Rules suspended. Read by title and referred to the Legislative Bureau.
HB7	Emerson	FUNDS/FUNDING	(Constitutional Amendment) Revises Article VII of the Constitution of La. (Items #1, 2, 7, and 14) - Reported with amendments. Rules suspended. Committee amendments read and adopted. Read by title and referred to the Legislative Bureau.
HB8	Brass	TAX/SALES & USE	Levies sales and use taxes on certain digital products and services (Items #8 and 13) - Reported favorably. Rules suspended. Read by title and referred to the Legislative Bureau.
HB10	Wright	TAX/SALES & USE	Provides for the rate of the state sales and use tax and provides for the exemptions, exclusions, credits, and rebates claimed against sales and use taxes (Item #8) - Reported with amendments. Rules suspended. Committee amendments read and adopted. Read by title and referred to the Legislative Bureau.
HB11	Deshotel	TAX/AD VALOREM TAX	Provides for the homestead exemption, special assessment level, and other property tax exemptions for purposes of determining ad valorem taxation of certain property (Items #1 and 10) - Reported with amendments. Rules suspended. Committee amendments read and adopted. Read by title and referred to the Legislative Bureau.

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HB12	Deshotel	FUNDS/FUNDING	Relative to finances of the state (Items #16 and 21) - Reported with amendments. Rules suspended. Committee amendments read and adopted. Read by title and referred to the Legislative Bureau.
HB13	Geymann	APPROPRIATIONS	Limits the amount of money that may be appropriated in a fiscal year (Item #14) - Reported with amendments. Rules suspended. Committee amendments read and adopted. Read by title and referred to the Legislative Bureau.
HB21	Bourriaque	TAX/SALES & USE	Requires the secretary of the Department of Revenue to annually estimate revenue derived from aviation fuel collections (Items #8 and 11) - Read by title, passed by a vote of 35 yeas and 0 nays, and ordered returned to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.
HB23	Geymann	MINERALS	Provides for the administration of the Oilfield Site Restoration Fund (Item #16) - Reported favorably. Rules suspended. Read by title and referred to the Legislative Bureau.
HB24	Geymann	MINERALS/MINERAL BOARD	Provides for the leasing of state property for energy-related purposes (Item #17) - Senate floor amendments read and adopted. Read by title, passed by a vote of 35 yeas and 0 nays, and ordered returned to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.
HB25	Riser	TAX/SEVERANCE TAX	Provides relative to severance tax on oil and gas and for dedication of certain severance tax revenues (Item #9) - Reported with amendments. Rules suspended. Committee amendments read and adopted. Read by title and referred to the Legislative Bureau.
