SB9	Miller, G.	CIVIL PROCEDURE	Provides for legislative continuances and extensions of time for legislators and legislative employees. (Item #20) (gov sig) <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Amendments proposed by the House read and concurred in by a vote of 39 yeas and 0 nays.</li><li>- Enrolled. Signed by the President of the Senate.</li><li>- Sent to the Governor by the Secretary of the Senate.</li></ul>
HB2	Emerson	TAX/CORP INCOME	Provides for a flat rate for purposes of calculating corporate income tax and terminates certain corporate income tax exemptions, deductions, and credits (Item #4) <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Rules suspended. Senate floor amendments read and adopted. Read by title, passed by a vote of 38 yeas and 1 nays, and ordered returned to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.</li></ul>
HB3	Emerson	TAX/CORP FRANCHISE	Repeals the corporation franchise tax and limits eligibility of certain credits to be claimed against corporation franchise tax (Item #3) <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Rules suspended. Senate floor amendments read and adopted. Read by title, passed by a vote of 39 yeas and 0 nays, and ordered returned to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.</li></ul>
HB4	McFarland	APPROPRIATIONS/SUPPLEML	Makes supplemental appropriations for Fiscal Year 2024-2025 (Items #18, 21, and 23) <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Rules suspended. Read by title, passed by a vote of 39 yeas and 0 nays, and ordered returned to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.</li></ul>
HB5	Bacala	TEACHERS/SALARY	Requires school systems to provide a salary increase for teachers and other school employees using savings attributable to the state's payment of certain unfunded accrued liability of the Teachers' Retirement System of Louisiana (Item #2) <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Rules suspended. Senate floor amendments read and adopted. Read by title, passed by a vote of 39 yeas and 0 nays, and ordered returned to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.</li></ul>
HB6	Beaullieu	ELECTIONS/SPECIAL	Calls a special statewide election on March 29, 2025, for submitting proposed constitutional amendments to the state's electors (Item #22)

- HB7 Emerson FUNDS/FUNDING  
(Constitutional Amendment) Revises Article VII of the Constitution of La. (Items #1, 2, 7, and 14)  
- Rules suspended. Senate floor amendments read and adopted. Read by title, passed by a vote of 39 yeas and 0 nays, and ordered returned to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.
- HB8 Brass TAX/SALES & USE  
Levies sales and use taxes on certain digital products and services (Items #8 and 13)  
- Rules suspended. Senate floor amendments read and adopted. Read by title, passed by a vote of 34 yeas and 5 nays, and ordered returned to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.
- HB10 Wright TAX/SALES & USE  
Provides for the rate of the state sales and use tax and provides for the exemptions, exclusions, credits, and rebates claimed against sales and use taxes (Item #8)  
- Rules suspended. Senate floor amendments read and adopted. Read by title, passed by a vote of 38 yeas and 1 nays, and ordered returned to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.
- HB11 Deshotel TAX/AD VALOREM TAX  
Provides for the homestead exemption, special assessment level, and other property tax exemptions for purposes of determining ad valorem taxation of certain property (Items #1 and 10)  
- Rules suspended. Senate floor amendments read and adopted. Read by title, passed by a vote of 29 yeas and 9 nays, and ordered returned to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.
- HB12 Deshotel FUNDS/FUNDING  
Relative to finances of the state (Items #16 and 21)  
- Rules suspended. Senate floor amendments read and adopted. Read by title, passed by a vote of 38 yeas and 0 nays, and ordered returned to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.
- HB13 Geymann APPROPRIATIONS  
Limits the amount of money that may be appropriated in a fiscal year (Item #14)  
- Rules suspended. Senate floor amendments read and adopted. Read by title, passed by a vote of 29 yeas and 9 nays, and ordered returned to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.
- HB23 Geymann MINERALS  
Provides for the administration of the Oilfield Site Restoration Fund (Item #16)  
- Rules suspended. Senate floor amendments read and adopted. Read by title, passed by a vote of 38 yeas and 0 nays, and ordered returned to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.
- HB24 Geymann MINERALS/MINERAL BOARD  
Provides for the leasing of state property for energy-related purposes (Item #17)  
- Signed by the President of the Senate.
- HB25 Riser TAX/SEVERANCE TAX  
Provides relative to severance tax on oil and gas and for dedication of certain severance tax revenues (Item #9)  
- Rules suspended. The amended bill was read by title, passed by a vote of 38 yeas and 0 nays, and ordered returned to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.
