SB5	Wheat	COURTS	Provides for the jurisdictional limit for the City Court of Hammond. (8/1/25) - Read by title. Ordered engrossed and passed to third reading and final passage.
SB9	Bass	CRIME/PUNISHMENT	Adds federal and state military installations and facilities to the locations over which the use of an unmanned aircraft system is prohibited. (8/1/25) - Read by title. Committee amendments read and adopted. Ordered engrossed and passed to third reading and final passage.
SB10	Boudreaux	OPTOMETRY	Provides relative to the Louisiana State Board of Optometry Examiners. (8/1/25) - Reported favorably.
SB11	Luneau	MOTOR VEHICLES	Provide for penalties for certain traffic offenses. (8/1/25) - Reported favorably.
SB17	Boudreaux	HEALTH SERVICES	Repeals the termination date of the Palliative Care Interdisciplinary Advisory Council. (gov sig) - Reported with amendments.
SB20	Wheat	LEGISLATIVE SESSIONS	Constitutional amendment to change the number of general bills a legislator may file during regular sessions that occur during odd-numbered years and for legislating with regard to dedication or rededication of funds. (2/3-CA13sl(A)) - Reported with amendments.
SB21	Wheat	CRIME/PUNISHMENT	Adds veterinarians and veterinary clinics to the definitions of "healthcare professional" and "healthcare facility" for purposes of certain assault and battery offenses. (8/1/25) - Read by title. Committee amendments read and adopted. Ordered engrossed and passed to third reading and final passage.
SB26	Boudreaux	PUBLIC HEALTH	Provides relative to diabetes information. (8/1/25) - Reported favorably.
SB38	Hensgens	CRIME/PUNISHMENT	Creates the crime of theft of gift cards or gift card redemption information. (8/1/25) - Read by title. Ordered engrossed and passed to third reading and final passage.
SB40	Wheat	INSURANCE DEPARTMENT	Updates licensure requirements for persons regulated by the Department of Insurance. (8/1/25) - Reported with amendments.

Provides for the treatment of certain pass through entities under the inventory tax credit. (gov sig)
- Read by title. Committee amendments read and adopted. Ordered engrossed and passed to third reading and final passage.
- SB72 Reese BONDS
Provides relative to the issuance of bonds for financing certain capital improvement projects within the Louisiana Community and Technical College System. (2/3-CA7s6(A))(7/1/25)
- Read by title. Committee amendments read and adopted. Ordered engrossed and passed to third reading and final passage.
- SB73 Reese ENVIRONMENTAL CONTROL
Provides for sequestration of carbon dioxide. (8/1/25)
- Rules suspended. Reported with amendments.
- SB75 Miller, G. CIVIL PROCEDURE
Provides for legislative continuances and extensions of time for legislators and legislative employees. (gov sig)
- Read by title. Ordered engrossed and passed to third reading and final passage.
- SB78 Myers CONTROL DANGER SUBSTANCE
Provides relative to drug paraphernalia. (gov sig)
- Read by title. Committee amendments read and adopted. Ordered engrossed and passed to third reading and final passage.
- SB98 Myers CONTROL DANGER SUBSTANCE
Increases the penalties for the retail sale of nitrous oxide. (8/1/25)
- Read by title. Committee amendments read and adopted. Ordered engrossed and passed to third reading and final passage.
- SB104 Price CHILDREN/FAMILY SERVICES DEPT
Provides relative to the Empowering Families to Live Well Louisiana Council. (gov sig)
- Reported with amendments.
- SB116 Kleinpeter NOTARIES
Provides for reciprocal notarial authority of notaries qualified in St. Martin Parish and St. Landry Parish. (8/1/25)
- Read by title. Ordered engrossed and passed to third reading and final passage.
- SB118 Foil TAX/INCOME/PERSONAL
Excludes certain amounts deposited into ABLE accounts for qualified expenses of persons with disabilities from state income tax. (8/1/25)
- Read by title. Ordered engrossed and passed to third reading and final passage.
- SB136 Talbot INSURERS
Provides for rate transparency reports. (1/1/26)
- Reported favorably.
- SB137 Talbot INSURERS
Requires insurers to notify the Department of Insurance upon ceasing, pausing, or resuming the writing of policies in a particular region. (1/1/26)

- SB144 Womack LOCAL FINANCE
Provides relative to the issuance of bonds by the Vidalia Port Commission. (gov sig)
- Read by title. Ordered engrossed and passed to third reading and final passage.
- SB145 McMath WATER/WATERWAYS
Provides relative to construction of bulkheads on certain water bodies in St. Tammany Parish. (gov sig)
- Rules suspended. Reported with amendments.
- SB146 Jackson-Andrews LOCAL FINANCE
Provides relative to the issuance of bonds by the Lake Providence Port Commission and the powers of the commission. (gov sig)
- Read by title. Ordered engrossed and passed to third reading and final passage.
- SB147 Jackson-Andrews LOCAL FINANCE
Provides relative to the issuance of bonds by the Tensas Parish Port, Harbor and Terminal District. (gov sig)

Provides for liberative prescription on mineral leases on state property. (8/1/25)

- SB233 Edmonds TAX/TAXATION
Provides for changes to the School Readiness Tax Credit. (1/1/26)
- Read second time by title and referred to the Committee on Revenue and Fiscal Affairs.
- SB234 Edmonds SCHOOLS
Creates and provides for the St. George Community School Board and school system in East Baton Rouge Parish. (See Act)
- Rules suspended. Introduced in the Senate. Read by title and placed on the Calendar for a second reading.
- SB235 Duplessis TAX/INCOME/PERSONAL
Establishes an individual income tax credit for payments made toward a homeowner's insurance policy premium. (1/1/26)
- Rules suspended. Introduced in the Senate. Read by title and placed on the Calendar for a second reading.
- SCR7 Foil COMMENDATIONS
Recognizes the Louisiana Civil Code on its bicentennial anniversary.
- Read by title and adopted by a vote of 33 yeas and 0 nays. Ordered sent to the House.
- SR24 Selders SPECIAL DAY/WEEK/MONTH
Commends the Louisiana Counseling Association and recognizes Wednesday, April 23, 2025, as Louisiana Counseling Association Day at the state capitol.
- Read by title and adopted.
- SR25 Duplessis CONDOLENCES
Extends deep and heartfelt condolences to the family and friends of Danielle Joy Raines on the occasion of her passing.
