USER'S GUIDE TO THE SUBJECT INDEX

1. **Legislative studies:** Studies by legislative committees (or bodies with legislators as members) are entered under *Legislative Affairs: Committee Studies*, and under a subject entry as well.
2. **Non-legislative studies:** Studies by non-legislative entities are entered in a subject section, but not under the agency conducting the study.
3. **Departmental entries:** Only bills directly affecting the organization and management of a department appear under the department/office entry. All programs and other responsibilities of departments are located under their subject heading(s). Administrative rule legislation appears under *Administration: Procedure*.
4. **Parish/municipal topics:** Most bills dealing with parishes and municipalities are entered under a specific subject heading, but are not entered under *Parishes* or *Municipalities*.
5. **Retirement systems:** Bills about the various retirement systems are only entered under *Retirement*. For example, bills dealing with firefighters' retirement will not appear under *Fire Protection & Officers*.
6. **Appropriations:** Bills that actually make an appropriation will only appear under the *Appropriations* heading.
