

**Chamber: House**

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- HB4 Toomy CLERKS OF COURT  
Authorizes any clerk of court to establish an ancillary office during a state of emergency (Item #68)  
- Read third time by title, roll called on final passage, yeas 101, nays 0. Finally passed, title adopted, ordered to the Senate.
- HB11 Smiley MTR VEHICLE/REGISTRATION  
Provides for disposal of water-damaged vehicles (Item #13)  
- Rules suspended, called out of its regular order.  
- Read third time by title, amended, roll called on final passage, yeas 70, nays 34. Finally passed, title adopted, ordered to the Senate.
- HB18 Hutter RETIREMENT BENEFITS  
Provides for public employees on involuntary furlough or leave without pay due to a disaster to continue to earn service credit in their retirement systems by making employee and employer contributions (Item #65)  
- Rules suspended, called out of its regular order.  
- Read third time by title, amended, roll called on final passage, yeas 102, nays 2. Finally passed, title adopted, ordered to the Senate.
- HB27 Salter ELECTIONS/SPECIAL  
Provides for a special statewide election for the purpose of submitting constitutional amendments to the electors of the state (Item #4)  
- Reported with amendments (7-0) (Regular).  
- Rules suspended. Read by title, amended, ordered engrossed, passed to 3rd reading - regular calendar.
- HB83 Alario APPROPRIATIONS/SUPPLEML  
Appropriates monies from the Budget Stabilization Fund for FY 2005-2006 (Item #30)  
- Read by title, returned to the calendar.
- HB93 Scalise SCHOOLS/DISTRICTS  
Provides an additional means by which public schools may be transferred to the state's Recovery School District and prohibits certain persons from serving on Type 5 Recovery District Charter school governing authorities (Item #8)  
- Rules suspended, called out of its regular order.  
- Read third time by title, amended, roll called on final passage, yeas 67, nays 36. Finally passed, title adopted, ordered to the Senate.
- HB97 Alario INSURANCE/GROUP-STATE  
Provides for certain benefits offered through the Office of Group Benefits programs for employees who were furloughed or terminated as a result of Hurricanes Katrina and Rita (Item #20)  
- Reported with amendments (14-0) (Regular).  
- Rules suspended. Read by title, amended, ordered engrossed, passed to 3rd reading - regular calendar.
- HB121 Crane SCHOOLS  
Provides for the transfer to and the operation, and management of certain schools by the Recovery School District, expands the authority of the recovery district, and provides for the duration of the transfer (Item #8)  
- Rules suspended, called out of its regular order.  
- Read third time by title, amended, roll called on final passage, yeas 89, nays 16. Finally passed, title adopted, ordered to the Senate.

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HB127	Martiny	CORRECTIONS/MEDICAL CARE	Provides for costs of medical care for prisoners - Read third time by title, roll called on final passage, yeas 67, nays 31. Finally passed, title adopted, ordered to the Senate.
HB136	LaFonta	ELECTIONS	Provides for parochial and municipal elections in a parish containing a municipality with a population of four hundred seventy-five thousand persons after a gubernatorial declaration of a state of emergency (Item #58) - Involuntarily deferred in committee.
HB138	Jefferson	ELECTIONS/DATES	Provides for parochial and municipal elections in a parish containing a municipality with a population of four hundred seventy-five thousand persons after a gubernatorial declaration of a state of emergency (Item #58) - Involuntarily deferred in committee.
HB139	Alario	FUNDS/FUNDING	(Constitutional Amendment) Changes the name of the Wetlands Conservation and Restoration Fund and provides for the deposit of certain federal revenues into the fund (Item #3) - Reported with amendments (16-0) (Regular). - Rules suspended. Read by title, amended, ordered engrossed, passed to 3rd reading - regular calendar.
HB140	Alario	FUNDS/FUNDING	Provides relative to the balance in the Budget Stabilization Fund (Item #19) - Read by title, returned to the calendar. - Notice given.
HB156	Alario	APPROPRIATIONS/SUPPLEML	Supplemental appropriations and reductions in appropriations for Fiscal Year 2005-2006 (Item #30) - Read by title, amended, ordered engrossed, passed to 3rd reading - regular calendar.
HB160	Montgomery	TECHNOLOGY	Provides with respect to the Louisiana Geographic Information System (Item #26) - Reported with amendments (7-0) (Regular). - Rules suspended. Read by title, amended, ordered engrossed, passed to 3rd reading - regular calendar.
HB161	Carter, K.	ATTORNEY GENERAL	Authorizes the attorney general to issue cease and desist orders to prohibit charter schools under certain circumstances - Read third time by title, roll called on final passage, yeas 30, nays 70. Failed to pass, motion to reconsider tabled.
HB163	Crowe	CONSUMERS/PROTECTION	Prohibits discrimination on terms for contracts for certain displaced persons as an unfair trade practice - Read by title, rules suspended, referred to the Committee on Commerce.
HB164	LaFonta	TAX/CORP FRANCHISE	Provides for the computation of borrowed capital by corporations affected by Hurricanes Katrina or Rita which have incurred extraordinary debt (Item #16)

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- Read by title, rules suspended, referred to the Committee on Ways and Means.

- HCR4 Hutter INSURANCE  
Memorializes congress to create the National Wind Insurance Program  
- Received from the Senate without amendments.
- HCR12 Bruneau COMMERCIAL REGULATIONS  
Urges and requests the state Office of Financial Institutions, the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation, and the federal Office of the Comptroller of the Currency to provide flexibility for the modification of loan terms for entities and persons affected by Hurricane Katrina or Rita  
- Received from the Senate without amendments.
- HCR13 Jefferson CURRICULA  
Requests BESE to develop and implement an age, grade, and geographically appropriate curriculum for disaster awareness education in all city, parish, and other local public school systems  
- Received from the Senate without amendments.
- HCR15 Schneider RETIREMENT/DROP  
Memorializes congress to grant for distributions from DROP accounts to active government employees who are members of public retirement systems similar tax relief to that provided by the Katrina Emergency Tax Relief Act of 2005  
- Received from the Senate without amendments.
- HCR23 Carter, K. INSURANCE/FLOOD  
Memorializes the United States Congress to increase the coverage limit for a single-family structure under the National Flood Insurance Program from \$250,000 to \$500,000  
- Received from the Senate without amendments.
- HCR24 Carter, K. INSURANCE/FLOOD  
Urges and requests the Louisiana Property and Casualty Insurance Commission to study and to work to bring more insurers who write supplemental flood insurance coverage into Louisiana  
- Received from the Senate without amendments.
- HCR25 Dorsey PUBLIC SFTY/CORRECT DEPT  
Provides with respect to emergency plans for displaced sex offenders  
- Received from the Senate without amendments.
- HCR27 Schneider RETIREMENT/DROP  
Memorializes congress to grant similar tax relief for Hurricane Rita victims as that provided by the Katrina Emergency Tax Relief Act of 2005 and to include DROP account distributions to active employees who are members of public retirement systems and victims of Katrina or Rita as eligible plan distributions  
- Received from the Senate without amendments.
- HCR31 Gray ELECTIONS  
Requests the Louisiana secretary of state to work cooperatively with other agencies to contact all displaced individuals to provide them information relative to their voting rights and how to register to vote and vote in upcoming elections  
- Received from the Senate without amendments.
- HCR38 Scalise EMPLOYMENT  
Memorializes congress to require all federal jobs that have been lost or relocated due to Hurricanes Katrina and Rita and their associated funding to be restored as soon as possible  
- Received from the Senate without amendments.

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- HCR40      LaFonta                      ENVIRONMENT  
Requests the Environmental Protection Agency to conduct a comprehensive study of the environment in the parishes affected by Hurricane Katrina.  
- Received from the Senate without amendments.
- HCR41      Odinet                          BUILDING CODES  
Memorialize congress to enjoin FEMA from mandating that structures rebuilt in the New Orleans area be elevated  
- Read by title, rules suspended, adopted, ordered to the Senate.
- HCR42      LaFonta                      CONGRESS  
Memorializes congress to develop and provide innovative solutions for financing housing in parishes devastated by Hurricanes Katrina and Rita  
- Read by title, rules suspended, adopted, ordered to the Senate.
- HCR43      Bowler                          INSURANCE/PROPERTY  
Memorializes congress to enact comprehensive natural disaster insurance legislation that will encourage insurance company reserving for future catastrophes by making such reserves deductible for federal income tax purposes  
- Read by title, rules suspended, adopted, ordered to the Senate.
- HCR44      Carter, K.                      INSURANCE/HEALTH  
Memorializes congress to enact a health insurance premium reimbursement program and a federal income tax credit for the health insurance premiums for affected victims of Hurricanes Katrina and Rita  
- Read by title, rules suspended, adopted, ordered to the Senate.
- HCR45      Crowe                           CHARITABLE ORGANIZATION  
Encourages the state attorney general and state treasurer to request records or other appropriate documentation from charities relative to any monetary donations collected on behalf of the state's hurricane victims  
- Read by title, rules suspended, adopted, ordered to the Senate.
- HR1        Hebert                          HOUSE/RULES  
Provides that it is only in order to consider one committee or floor amendment with a fiscal cost over \$100,000 to any appropriation bill at any one time  
- Reported favorably (9-0).  
- Rules suspended. Read by title, ordered engrossed, passed to 3rd reading.
- HR2        Hebert                          HOUSE/RULES  
Requires an identification of corresponding legislative districts for each item or project in an appropriation or capital outlay bill or amendment thereto  
- Involuntarily deferred in committee.
- HR9        Hebert                          HOUSE/RULES  
Provides the voting machine does not indicate a member's vote to any person until the machine is closed  
- Involuntarily deferred in committee.
- SB1        Amedee                          SEX OFFENSES  
Provides for registration of sex offenders in emergency housing, enhances penalties for failure to register, and requires re-registration under certain circumstances.  
- Called from the calendar.  
- Read by title, amended and designated duplicate of HB 26.

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- Referred to the Legislative Bureau.

- SB27 Dupre FUNDS/FUNDING  
Constitutional amendment to change name of Wetlands Conservation and Restoration Fund to Coastal Protection and Restoration Fund, and provide that certain federal revenues received by the state generated from Outer Continental Shelf oil and gas activity shall be credited to the fund and used only for certain purposes.  
- Received in the House from the Senate, rules suspended, read by title, lies over under the rules
- SB28 Dupre COASTAL RESOURCES  
Changes name of Wetlands Conservation and Restoration Fund to Coastal Protection and Restoration Fund and provides for deposit and uses of the fund.  
- Received in the House from the Senate, rules suspended, read by title, lies over under the rules
- SB70 Ullo SCHOOLS  
Eliminates limit on maximum number of charter schools that can be created.  
- Received in the House from the Senate, rules suspended, read by title, lies over under the rules
- SB71 Dupre COASTAL RESOURCES  
Authorizes development and implementation of a comprehensive coastal protection plan. (gov sig)  
- Received in the House from the Senate, rules suspended, read by title, lies over under the rules
- SCR9 Ullo SCHOOLS  
Suspends certain provisions governing the operation of and formation of charter schools.  
- Received in the House from the Senate.
- SCR15 Ullo FUNDS/FUNDING  
Approves adjustments adopted by BESE on 11/9/2005 to the MFP formula for FY 2005-06 approved by the Legislature as SCR 125 of the 2005 R.S.  
- Reported without action, (16-0) with recommendation to recommit to the Committee on Education.  
- Rules suspended. Read by title, recommitted to the Committee on Education.
- SCR21 Hines HEALTH/HOSPITALS DEPT  
Requests the Department of Health and Hospitals, Department of Social Services, and the office of homeland security to include the Louisiana Emergency Response Network and its board in any and all decisions regarding emergency and disaster preparation and response.  
- Received in the House from the Senate.  
- Read by title, rules suspended, concurred in.
- SCR22 Gautreaux, B. CONGRESS  
To memorialize Congress to reduce or eliminate the Windfall Elimination Provision and the Government Pension Offset  
- Received in the House from the Senate.  
- Read by title, rules suspended, concurred in.
