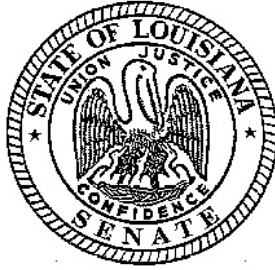

**SB 12 MILLS, ROBERT HEALTH CARE** Provides access for patients of hospitals and residents of nursing homes, assisted living facilities, and other adult residential care homes to members of the clergy who volunteer to minister and provide religious sacraments and services, counseling, and mental health support during COVID-19 and other public health emergencies. (gov sig) (Item #28)

- SB 13 PEACOCK HEALTH SERVICES** Provides for the Recognition of Emergency Medical Services Personnel Licensure Interstate Compact (REPLICA). (7/1/21) (Item #44)
- SB 27 PEACOCK HEALTH CARE** Provides relative to the practice of medicine. (2/3 - CA7s2.1(A)) (7/1/21) (Item #45)
- SB 34 PEACOCK SPEECH/PATH/AUDIO** Provides for the Audiology and Speech-Language Pathology Interstate Compact (ASLP-IC). (7/1/21) (Item #37)
- SB 51 BARROW PHARMACISTS** Provides for immunizations, including the COVID-19 vaccine, to be administered by pharmacists. (gov sig) (Item #40)
- SB 53 MCMATH EMPLOYMENT** Provides for the rehiring of nonlicensed persons by certain health care providers required to temporarily close during a public health emergency. (gov sig) (Item #28)
- SB 58 JOHNS NURSING HOMES** Provides relative to the licensing of health care providers after an emergency or disaster. (gov sig) (Item #32)
