

The Louisiana Legislature is seeking a Director of Capitol Security

The Director of Capitol Security will oversee law enforcement and physical security for the legislative branch of state government subject to the general direction and supervision of the Capitol Security Council. The domicile of the position is Baton Rouge, La.

Minimum qualifications for the position include POST certification, at least 10 years of full-time law enforcement experience, and possession of the qualifications necessary to be commissioned as a special officer. Applicants will be required to undergo a comprehensive background check.

The duties and functions of the position include development and implementation of a comprehensive security plan for the legislature and its facilities, preparation of an annual budget, and management and supervision of security officers and other office personnel.

The salary offered for the position will be commensurate with experience and qualifications. The salary range for the position is \$75,000 to \$135,000, inclusive of benefits.

Interested applicants should submit a resume, including proof of POST certification, to the Office of the Senate President and the Office of the Speaker of the House of Representatives no later than **5:00 PM on Friday, September 30, 2022**.
