

4. A digest of the legislative instrument as proposed.

Proposed Joint Rule requires the conference committee report and digest to be made available to the legislators electronically on the Joint Legislative Website for at least 24 hours prior to a vote by either legislative house.

Proposed Joint Rule provides that either house of the legislature may waive the above requirements as it applies to the procedures of such house of the legislature by a majority vote of the elected members of such house.

Provides that the Rule shall become effective upon adoption.

(Adopts Joint Rule No. 19.1)

Summary of Amendments Adopted by Senate

Senate Floor Amendments to original bill

1. Clarifies that the 24-hour period begins upon receipt of the conference committee report by the chief clerical officer of the voting house.
2. Specifies the information to be included in a conference committee report and digest.
3. Specifies that a conference committee report and digest shall be electronically available to legislative members on the Joint Legislative Website for 24 hours prior to a vote.
4. Adds co-authors.
