1                                   A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

2       To commend and congratulate Collier "P. J." Brown Jr. on being named to the 2016  
3                   Louisiana Sports Hall of Fame.

4               WHEREAS, the Louisiana Sports Hall of Fame in Natchitoches, Louisiana, each year  
5       collaborates with the Louisiana Sports Writers Association in selecting a limited number of  
6       sports figures who embody the character, skill, and talents worthy of being named to the hall  
7       of fame; and

8               WHEREAS, the 2016 Louisiana Sports Hall of Fame Induction Class includes  
9       basketball great P. J. Brown; and

10              WHEREAS, a former Winnfield Senior High School and Louisiana Tech University  
11       standout, P. J. Brown played fifteen years in the National Basketball Association (NBA)  
12       with five teams, including four years with the New Orleans Hornets; and

13              WHEREAS, as a second-round draft pick of the New Jersey Nets in 1992, where he  
14       played for three years, he distinguished himself as a defensive stalwart during his career; and

15              WHEREAS, from 1996 until 2000, he played with the Miami Heat, where he  
16       received the J. Walter Kennedy Citizenship Award, was named to the NBA All-Defensive  
17       Second Team twice, and averaged a career high of 11.4 points a game; and

18              WHEREAS, on August 1, 2000, P. J. Brown was traded to the Charlotte Hornets and
