16(5) "Miscarriage or stillbirth" means the spontaneous or accidental17death of an unborn child, whether the death occurred in the womb or in the18process of birth. Death of the unborn child is indicated by the lack of signs of19breathing or any other evidence of life, such as beating of the heart, pulsation20of the umbilical cord, or definite movement of voluntary muscles.

<u>C.(1) Nothing in this Section shall be construed to prohibit any</u> transaction related to the final disposition of the bodily remains of the aborted human being in accordance with state law, or to prohibit any conduct permitted under state law that is undertaken with any of the following purposes:

(a) The purpose of providing knowledge solely to the mother, such as for pathological or diagnostic purposes.

(b) The purpose of providing knowledge solely to law enforcement officers, such as the case of an autopsy following a feticide.

29 (2) Nothing in this Section shall be construed to prohibit the donation
30 of bodily remains from a human embryo or fetus whose death was caused by a
31 natural miscarriage or stillbirth, in accordance with the guidelines and
32 prohibitions provided in applicable state and federal law.

1	(3) Nothing in this Section shall be construed to affect existing federal
2	or state law regarding the practice of abortion, or to create or recognize a right
3	to abortion."
