AGRICULTURE: Adds certain prohibitions relative to fraud by vendors or by the purchaser in the sale of certain food

Synopsis of Senate Amendments

1. Makes a technical change.

Digest of Bill as Finally Passed by Senate

Present law prohibits the misrepresentation of the name, or type of any fruit, vegetable, grain, meat, or fish, including catfish, sold, or offered for sale, to any actual or prospective consumer.

Proposed law adds the origin of certain foods and shellfish to the list of items that may not be misrepresented when being sold, or offered or exposed for sale, to any actual or prospective consumer.
