Amendments proposed by House Committee on Health and Welfare to Reengrossed Senate Bill No. 291 by Senator Mills

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 2, after "R.S. 37:2418(B)" and before "and to" insert "and 2420(B) and (C),
 3 to enact R.S. 37:2420(D),"

4 AMENDMENT NO. 2

5 On page 1, line 4, after "circumstances;" and before "to provide" insert "to provide grounds
 6 for disciplinary actions by the Louisiana Physical Therapy Board;"

7 AMENDMENT NO. 3

8 On page 1, line 7, after "R.S. 37:2418(B)" delete the remainder of the line and insert in lieu
 9 thereof "and 2420(B) and (C) are hereby amended and reenacted and R.S. 37:2420(D) is
 10 hereby enacted to read as follows:"

11 AMENDMENT NO. 4

12 On page 2, between lines 5 and 6, insert the following:

13 "§2420. Disciplinary actions

14 * * *

15 B.(1) After due notice, the board may suspend the license of any person
 16 who fails to timely refer a patient to an appropriate healthcare provider as
 17 required by the provisions of R.S. 37:2418(B).

18 (2) If after a hearing concerning any violation provided in Paragraph
 19 (1) of this Subsection the board substantiates the violation, the board may
 20 revoke the license of the person who committed the violation and shall fine the
 21 person the greater of the following amounts:

22 (a) One thousand dollars.

23 (b) The amount of compensation the person received for the services
 24 which were the basis of the violation.

25 ~~B. C.~~ Any action of the board taken under this Section shall be subject to
 26 notice requirements and hearing, adjudication, and appeal proceedings in accordance
 27 with the rules adopted by the board and the Administrative Procedure Act.

28 ~~C. D.~~ Refusal to grant a license for failure to pass the licensing examination
 29 required by the board shall not require notice and a hearing."
