1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 2, after "(introductory paragraph)," delete the remainder of the line and on  
3 line 3, delete "enact R.S. 34:2471(A)(9)" and insert "(3), (4), (5), and (6) and to"

4 AMENDMENT NO. 2

5 On page 1, line 6, after "(introductory paragraph)," delete the remainder of the line and insert  
6 "(3), (4), (5), and (6) are hereby" and on line 7, after "reenacted" delete "and R.S.  
7 34:2471(A)(9) is hereby enacted"

8 AMENDMENT NO. 3

9 On page 1, delete lines 15 through 22 and insert the following:

10 " (3) Two members shall be appointed by the governor from a list of one nominee  
11 from each parish located within the territorial jurisdiction of the port who is a  
12 resident of such parish, ~~or who may, instead of holding residency, be the chief  
13 executive officer of a business which is principally operated within each parish from~~  
14 the list of nominees submitted to him by each of the following organizations:

- 15 (a) Louisiana Farm Bureau.  
16 (b) Louisiana AFL-CIO.  
17 (c) Southern University River Parishes Alumni Association.  
18 (d) River Region Chamber of Commerce.

19 (4) One member shall be appointed by the governor from a list of one nominee each  
20 from each parish located within the territorial jurisdiction of the port who is a  
21 resident of such parish, ~~or who may, instead of residency, be the chief executive  
22 officer of a business which is principally operated~~ from the list of nominees  
23 submitted to him by each of the following organizations:

- 24 (a) River Parishes Chemical Industry Council.  
25 (b) Grain Elevator and Processing Society.  
26 (c) Greater New Orleans Barge Fleeting Association.  
27 (d) New Orleans and Baton Rouge Port Pilots Association.  
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29 ~~(5) One member-at-large who shall reside and be domiciled within the geographical  
30 boundaries of the port shall be appointed by the governor. The person appointed shall  
31 be selected on the basis of his demonstrated experience in civic leadership and his  
32 ability and experience to act effectively for the best interest of the port and the state  
33 of Louisiana. Three members, one of whom is a resident of St. Charles Parish, one  
34 of whom is a resident of St. John the Baptist Parish, and one of whom is a resident  
35 of St. James Parish, shall be appointed by the governor at his sole discretion.~~

37 (6) ~~From the nominees submitted to the governor for appointment he shall select one  
38 resident from each parish located within the territorial jurisdiction of the port, one  
39 of whom may, instead of residency, be the chief executive officer of a business  
40 which is principally operated within such parish. In making appointments to the  
41 commission from among the nominees submitted to the governor as provided in  
42 Paragraphs (3), (4), and (5) of this Subsection, the governor shall appoint members  
43 in a manner to ensure that three of the members shall be residents of St. Charles  
44 Parish, three shall be residents of St. John the Baptist Parish, and three shall be  
45 residents of St. James Parish.~~
