18 referral from a person licensed to practice medicine, surgery, dentistry,
19 podiatry, or chiropractic shall not be construed to mandate coverage for
20 physical therapy services under any health care plan, insurance policy, or
21 workers' compensation plan or circumvent any requirement for
22 preauthorization of services in accordance with any health care plan,
23 insurance policy, or workers' compensation plan.

24 (2) Prior to providing any physical therapy service, physical
25 therapists shall provide each patient written notification that the service
26 may not be covered by insurance or workers' compensation. The
27 physical therapist shall obtain written acknowledgment from the patient
28 that the patient has been informed of the possibility of out-of-pocket
29 expenses.

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
