

**HOUSE SUMMARY OF SENATE AMENDMENTS****HB 85****2016 Regular Session****Davis**

DISTRICTS/CRIME PREVENT: Provides relative to the Broadmoor Crime Prevention and Improvement District in East Baton Rouge Parish

**Synopsis of Senate Amendments**

1. Makes the proposed law expansion of the district's boundaries and the imposition of a parcel fee within such boundaries subject to voter approval.
2. Requires the district to provide services to property owners located within the expanded boundaries upon receipt of the parcel fee payment.
3. Remainder of amendments are technical.

**Digest of Bill as Finally Passed by Senate**

Present law creates the Broadmoor Crime Prevention and Improvement District in East Baton Rouge Parish for the purpose of aiding in crime prevention and adding to the security of district residents by providing for an increase in the presence of law enforcement personnel in the district. Provides that the district is governed by a seven-member board of commissioners and provides for district boundaries.

Proposed law retains present law but provides for the expansion of the district's boundaries and the imposition of a parcel fee within such boundaries, subject to voter approval. Provides that the boundaries of the district shall be expanded on January 1st following the election. Requires the district to begin providing services to property owners located within the expanded boundaries upon receipt of the parcel fee payment.

Effective upon signature of governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
