Amendments proposed by Senate Committee on Senate and Governmental Affairs to Reengrossed House Bill No. 876 by Representative Leger

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 2, between lines 22 and 23, insert the following:

3 "(3) Notwithstanding the provisions of this Section, any filing filed by an individual
4 from a parish with a population of one hundred thousand or less according to the
5 latest federal decennial census may be filed by facsimile transmission or mail."

6 AMENDMENT NO. 2

7 On page 4, between lines 24 and 25, insert the following:

8 "(3) Notwithstanding the provisions of this Section, any filing filed by an individual
9 from a parish with a population of one hundred thousand or less according to the
10 latest federal decennial census may be filed by facsimile transmission or mail."

11 AMENDMENT NO. 3

12 On page 5, between lines 20 and 21, insert the following:

13 "(3) Notwithstanding the provisions of this Section, any filing filed by an individual
14 from a pariah with a population of one hundred thousand or less according to the
15 latest federal decennial census may be filed by facsimile transmission or mail."

16 AMENDMENT NO. 4

17 On page 6, after line 22, insert the following:

18 "E. Notwithstanding the provisions of this Section, any filing filed by an individual
19 from a parish with a population of one hundred thousand or less according to the
20 latest federal decennial census may be filed by facsimile transmission or mail."

21 AMENDMENT NO. 5

22 On page 6, after line 22, insert the following:

23 "Section 2. This Act shall become effective on January 1, 2018."
