

Proposed law requires OMV to propose an amnesty program for violations of R.S. 32:57.1 (failure to honor a promise) and R.S. 32:863.1 (no evidence of insurance) to be approved by the House and Senate committees on transportation, highways, and public works by January 1, 2017.

Proposed law prohibits OMV from pursuing collection of fines for violations of R.S. 32:57.1 and R.S. 32:863.1 until July 1, 2017.

Effective August 1, 2016.

(Adds R.S. 32:9)

Summary of Amendments Adopted by Senate

Committee Amendments Proposed by Senate Committee on Transportation, Highways, and Public Works to the original bill

1. Limits the amnesty program to violations of R.S. 32:863 (no insurance).
2. Provides for different per violation and total amnesty caps for violations before July 1, 2014, penalty rate increase and for violations on or after July 1, 2014.
3. Requires OMV to propose an amnesty program for fines for failure to appear and no evidence of insurance.
4. Prohibits collection action on fines for failure to appear and no evidence of insurance until July 1, 2017.
