2	To commend the Teurlings Catholic High School baseball team upon winning the 2016
3	Class 4A state championship.
4	WHEREAS, the Teurlings Rebels reveled in a come-from-behind win on Saturday,
5	May 14, 2016, to take the Class 4A state title over West Ouachita with a 3-2 win; and
6	WHEREAS, under the leadership of head coach Michael Thibodeaux, the Teurlings
7	Rebels completed a season of thirty-five wins against just four losses, was undefeated in
8	District play with a 10-0 record, and was ranked third in the Louisiana High School Athletic
9	Association (LHSAA) tournament before winning the Class 4A state championship; and
10	WHEREAS, the Rebels' bats began to make hit music in the bottom of the fourth
11	inning when Jacob Richard doubled to left field to push Chaney Dodge home for a tying run
12	at 1-1; and
13	WHEREAS, never losing their composure when the West Ouachita Chiefs retook the
14	lead in the top of the fifth, Teurlings pitcher Josh Taylor hit a triple off the left field wall in
15	the bottom of the fifth and scored when Hayden Cantrelle doubled to right field, bringing the
16	game to a 2-2 tie; and
17	WHEREAS, the Rebels ran a play that had been successful throughout the season:
18	a Brett Weber bunt gave Cantrelle the opportunity to score from second base and Teurlings
19	took a 3-2 lead they never relinquished; and

1	WHEREAS, the victory achieved in this year's Class 4A LHSAA championship final
2	is the result of years of hard work by the student athletes, solid coaching, commitment from
3	parents, and the backing of the school and community; and
4	WHEREAS, the members of the team performed at the highest levels of excellence
5	throughout the season, and each Teurlings Rebel deserves recognition for his vital
6	contributions to the winning effort; and
7	WHEREAS, seniors Chaney Dodge, Austin Kirkpatrick, Matthew McMillan, Jacob
8	Richard, Josh Taylor, and Brett Weber; juniors Garrett Boudreaux, Hayden Cantrelle, Max
9	Doucet, Evan Mire, Kade Sonnier, and Nick Webre; sophomores Hayden Arnaud, Isaac
10	Boulanger, Grant Clark, Kanin Dodge, Kalun Dronette, Trevor Dupre, Judson Judice, Hunter
11	Landry, and Dylan Langlinais; and freshmen Blake Blanchard, Zachary Bourque, Connor
12	Dickinson, Jaxon Dugas, Braxton Gallet, Barry Pepiton, Jacob Pepiton, Tate Simon,
13	Nicholas Taylor, and Caleb Whittington were guided by head coach Michael Thibodeaux
14	and his assistants, Richey Garrett and Brock Broussard; with the year-long support of team
15	manager Ashton Brignac, trainer Ricky Landry, and statistician Lindsey Hargrave, the hard
16	work and dedication of the team led to this year's championship; and
17	WHEREAS, it is fitting to recognize the well-deserved title the Teurlings Rebels
18	have earned; to commend the team members for the ability they have displayed, particularly
19	at the most difficult level of competition; and to express sincere and heartfelt congratulations
20	to the athletes, support staff, and coaches for the merits earned and the sportsmanship shown
21	while achieving the highest state boys' baseball honor possible for Teurlings Catholic High
22	School.
23	THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the House of Representatives of the
