<u>Present law</u> provides that an estate situated below is bound to receive the surface waters that flow naturally from an estate situated above, unless an act of man has created the flow.

Proposed law provides that an estate situated below is the servient estate and is bound to receive the surface waters flowing naturally from a dominant estate situated above, unless an act of man has created the flow.

Present law provides that the owner of the servient estate may not do anything to prevent the flow of the water. Present law further provides that the owner of the dominant estate may not do anything to render the servitude more burdensome.

Proposed law provides that the owner of the servient estate situated below may not do anything to prevent the flow of the water. Proposed law further provides that the owner of the dominant estate situated above may not do anything to render the servitude more burdensome.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
