ACT 390 (SB 350)

2016 Regular Session

Luneau

Prior law authorized district court clerks and the clerk of the Second City Court of the city of New Orleans to issue certified copies of short-form birth certificate cards and long-form birth certificates and death certificates. Required the clerk of court to collect, in addition to fees collected for issuance of copies of birth records or death certificates, a five dollar fee for a short form and nine dollars for a long form which the clerk pays to the state registrar.

New law increases the fee from nine dollars to nineteen dollars for a long form.

Prior law required the clerks to pay the fees collected for certified copies of birth records or death certificates to the state registrar. New law retains this provision.

Prior law authorized that the clerk of courts in East Feliciana Parish and West Feliciana Parish may charge an additional ten dollar fee for issuance of certified copies of birth certificates and death certificates. New law repeals this provision.

Effective August 1, 2016.
