Provides relative to the possession and consumption of alcoholic beverages by persons under the age of 18

Proposed law enacts R.S.14.93.12.1 relative to the unlawful possession of alcoholic beverages and crime prohibiting possession or consumption of alcoholic beverages by a person under eighteen years of age. Proposed law provides for exceptions, criminal penalties, and related matters. Proposed law provides penalties of a fine of not more than \$25 for a first offense and a fine of not more than \$100 for any subsequent offense.

EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

There is no anticipated direct material effect on state governmental expenditures as a result of this measure.

REVENUE EXPLANATION

The proposed law may result in an indeterminable increase in local funds revenue as result of potential fines. Proposed law provides for a fine of not more than \$25 for a first offense and not more than \$100 for any subsequent offense, if certain persons under eighteen years of age unlawfully "possess" or consume alcoholic beverages as a result of not being in the direct supervision of a parent or legal guardian who is twenty-one years of age or older. The potential revenue will accrue to the local governing authority.

Proposed law retains present law for a maximum \$100 fine for any person under twenty-one years of age convicted of unlawful purchase or have "public possession" of any alcoholic beverage.
