KEYWORD AND SUMMARY AS RETURNED TO THE SENATE

PUBLIC EMPLOYEES. Prohibits any cost-of-living or performance adjustment, or other salary increase for unclassified employees in the executive branch from being made in the last 90 days of the last year of a governor's term unless approved by the Joint Legislative Committee on the Budget. (gov sig)

SUMMARY OF HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO THE SENATE BILL

1. Applies the bill only to unclassified employees.

DIGEST OF THE SENATE BILL AS RETURNED TO THE SENATE

<u>Present law</u> provides for budget controls on personnel, including establishing the number of authorized positions for each budget unit, program, and subprogram; tracking personnel transactions against authorized positions; procedures for requesting personnel transactions; approvals required by the director of state civil service; other procedures to be approved by the Department of State Civil Service; and the authority of the governor, the civil service commission, the commissioner of administration, to regulate, control, or prohibit personnel transactions.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains these provisions but also authorizes the Joint Legislative Committee on the Budget to regulate, control, or prohibit any personnel transactions.

<u>Proposed law</u> prohibits cost-of-living increases, performance adjustments, or other general salary increases for unclassified employees in any budget unit, agency, or department of the executive branch during the last 90 days of the last year of a governor's term unless approved by the Joint Legislative Committee on the Budget. Requires that other relevant provisions in current law shall be satisfied before any increase takes effect.

Effective July 1, 2016.
