COMMENDATIONS. Commends Benton Middle School for earning the first-ever national championship in the 2016 National Archery in Schools Program national tournament.

2	To commend Benton Middle School for earning the first-ever national championship
3	representing Louisiana in the 2016 National Archery in Schools Program national
4	tournament.
5	WHEREAS, the students of Benton Middle School in Benton, Louisiana participated
6	in the 2016 National Archery in Schools Program national tournament in Louisville,
7	Kentucky, on May 12 through 14, where two hundred and six middle school teams from all
8	over the country competed for the first time in this national event; and
9	WHEREAS, Benton Middle School's team was led by eighth graders Aidan Haire,
10	who finished tenth in the boys middle school division, and Abbie Rutledge, who finished
11	fifteenth in the girls middle school division; and
12	WHEREAS, the middle school team scored a total of thirty four hundred and four
13	points winning the championship by a slim margin of only eight points over Pulaski
14	Northern Middle School of Kentucky; and
15	WHEREAS, the 2015-2016 Benton Middle school archery team members are: Trip

7	WHEREAS, the Benton Middle School team claimed a world title at last year's world
8	tournament, a year before the national tournament was instituted, and the team is eligible to
9	take part in the National Archery in Schools Program World Tournament in Myrtle Beach,
10	South Carolina on June 24 through 26, 2016; and
11	WHEREAS, the archery team has been training, practicing, and participating in
12	meets throughout the school year with the goal of competing and winning the first-ever
13	national archery title; and
14	WHEREAS, nearly two hundred Louisiana student archers from fourteen schools
15	participated in the state tournament in March, and nearly thirteen thousand students from
16	across the nation competed for a chance to represent their states at the national tournament;
17	and
18	WHEREAS, the Benton Middle School archery team participates in Archery in
19	Louisiana Schools, a program of the Louisiana Department of Natural Resources that offers
20	grants to purchase a portion of the equipment necessary for schools to participate in the
21	National Archery in Schools Program curriculum; and
22	WHEREAS, the National Archery in Schools Program is a target archery program
23	designed to achieve specific education and conservation purposes, it is designed to be taught
24	during the school day in the school gymnasium, and is highly standardized to maintain
25	archery's record of exceptional safety; and
26	WHEREAS, the National Archery in Schools Program for students in grades four
27	through twelve has two specific goals, first to improve student motivation, behavior,
28	attendance, and focus in relation to education while seeking to encourage students to spend
29	more time in the outdoors and to learn outdoor skills that will inspire them to spend more

time with wild things in wild places.
